*RCCCCPI announces the International Travel Fellowships 2011 Scheme.*

International Travel Fellowships will be awarded to full members of RCCCCPI for research visits to establish or develop intense research links with colleagues at top international universities (e.g. from SJTU top 500 institutions) or other high quality research institutions

ELIGIBILITY	Applicants must at time of application: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hold a continuing appointment at least 0.5 FTE in Griffith Health at Lecturer, Senior Lecturer, Research Fellow, associate professor, professor</li> <li>• Hold a PhD</li> <li>• Be a full member of RCCCCPI</li> </ul>
NUMBER	Up to 3 International Travel Fellowships of \$5,000 each will be awarded in 2011 for a minimum of one week stay
CRITERIA	Quality and potential merit of the visit will be the primary criterion on which applications are judged: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The ability of the applicant as determined by track record (e.g. national reputation as evidenced by the receipt of national competitive grants)</li> <li>• The profile of the collaborator at the host institution as determined by his/her track record</li> <li>• The international standing of the host institution, as indicated by appropriate KPIs</li> <li>• The quality of the aims, significance, research plan and outcomes of the research collaboration</li> <li>• Likelihood of benefits to GU and RCCCCPI including establishment and/or continuation of a long-term research collaboration, funded by external funding sources and leading to high profile collaborative publications</li> <li>• Applications seeking to leverage external international collaborative schemes will be given priority over otherwise equally ranked applications.</li> </ul>
SUBMISSION PROCESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applications must be submitted on the International Travel Fellowship Application Form</li> <li>• Applications must be 12 point font and double spaced</li> <li>• Applications are to be submitted via email in PDF format, as a single document to <a href="mailto:rcccpi@griffith.edu.au">rcccpi@griffith.edu.au</a>, clearly marked in the subject line: Int. Travel Fellowships by COB <b>30th May 2011</b>(deadline)</li> <li>• No extensions to the deadline will be granted</li> <li>• Applications will be acknowledged by return email</li> </ul> Incomplete or late applications will not be considered by the panel
SELECTION PROCESS	Applications will be considered confidentially by the following panel: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Director (Chair)</i></li> <li>• <i>Deputy Director</i></li> <li>• <i>Unit Leaders</i></li> </ul> The selection panel will be supported by the RCCCCPI Administrative Manager. All applicants will be advised of the outcomes of the selection process by email.
REPORTING OUTCOMES	Successful applicants must agree to report on outcomes of the international visit.
