About the Presentation

In the last decade, workplace bullying has attracted increased attention from researchers and practitioners globally, because of its serious economic and psychological costs. Research into workplace bullying has largely grown out of Scandinavian investigations into schoolyard bullying (McCarthy & Mayhew, 2004), which began in the late 1970s (Smith & Brain, 2000). Since then, research into schoolyard bullying has spread internationally to countries including the United Kingdom, a range of European countries, Australia, and New Zealand, with research into workplace bullying following (Smith & Brain, 2000).

Michael Harvey is a renowned researcher in the field of Workplace Bullying along with his research into Global Leadership. He has investigated the ethics of bullying, bullying in global organisations and bullying and leadership.
