### AUSTRALIAN FEDERATION OF AIR PILOTS SCHOLARSHIP

The objectives of the Scholarship are to assist with costs associated with study in attaining an aviation career and helping a student who would have difficulty in undertaking study because of financial hardship.

The Scholarship is valued at \$1000. To be eligible, applicants must be full-time students studying an Aviation undergraduate academic program.

It is expected that applicants would be achieving at a credit level or above in their studies (GPA 5.0). Applicants must be able to demonstrate the personal qualities to become a commercial pilot such as airmanship; leadership; and a respect for peers.

Applicants must be Australian citizens.

Selection will be based on review and assessment of applications.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection will be based on the following criteria (Attach to your application form in a resume format evidence of the following):

- Current Full-time Student undertaking a Undergraduate Griffith Aviation program
- Demonstrated leadership potential
- Demonstrated practical competencies gained through practical experience (ie. Laboratory works or projects undertaken throughout the semester/s)
- Demonstrated past academic merit ( i.e. Any awards or scholarships)
- Australian Citizen
- Available to be interviewed by the Assessment Panel.

3. Section 4 Attach the brief statement on Financial Hardship (attach evidence of your financial disadvantage)
4. Section 5 Attach a typed brief statement of no more than 300 words your personal qualities to become a commercial pilot.
5. Sign and date the Declaration.
6. Submit application form by the due date.
  
7. Applicants will be notified within 12 working days of receipt of the application by the Undergraduate Scholarships Office via the student email.
8. If short listed you may be required to attend an interview.
9. All Applicants will be notified about the outcome of their application.
