

## A Smart Strategy

Upon successful completion of your continuing education certificate program, you will receive a grade point average (GPA). This represents your average result for all your courses.

Courses are graded as follows:

- 7 = High Distinction
- 6 = Distinction
- 5 = Credit
- 4 = Pass
- 3 = Pass Conceded
- 1.5 = Fail
- 0 = Withdrawal with Failure

To give you an example, you may receive a 'Credit' and a 'Distinction' in Semester 1 and a 'Pass' and a 'Credit' in Semester 2. Your grade point average (GPA) would be calculated as follows:

$$(5 + 6 + 4 + 5) / 4 = 5$$

Your grade point average (GPA) gives you a boosted ranking that is equivalent to the Rank/OP/ATAR scores below:
