

## RCCCPi/SONM/POPULATION HEALTH EARLY CAREER PUBLICATION WORKSHOP SCHEME (2011)

RCCCPi announces an ECR PUBLICATION WORKSHOP scheme for 2011. The ECR PUBLICATION WORKSHOP scheme aims to assist ECR's with writing and submission of one publication. A maximum of 20 participants (10 in each workshop) will be selected.

ELIGIBILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Applicants must hold a contract or continuing appointment at least 0.5 FTE in Griffith Health or Research Fellow or above, and be a member or associate member of RCCCPi or SONM or Population Health</li> <li>Early career researcher is defined as less than five years since completion of PhD as at the closing date for award applications. In this scheme PhD candidates may also apply.</li> <li>Applicants must commit to the full week (5 days)</li> <li>Applicants must have a draft manuscript to work on and be thoroughly familiar with the literature in the area of the paper being written. Evidence of this draft may be requested by the review panel.</li> </ul>
NUMBER	Two workshops will be run in 2011. Please indicate in your application your preference for week of <b>4<sup>th</sup> July</b> ( <u>Logan Campus</u> ) or/and week of <b>26<sup>th</sup> September</b> 2011 ( <u>Gold Coast Campus</u> )
SEMINAR PRESENTER	Dr Robert Brown, an experienced researcher, author, and former academic. He now specialises in teaching scholars how to write for publication.
CRITERIA	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An EOI outlining the state of your draft publication, i.e dot points, or full draft; target journal and Journal ERA rank; planned date of submission of publication</li> <li>A supportive letter from mentor or PhD supervisor supporting your application to attend</li> <li>2 page track record (relative to opportunity) including quality and quantity of publications and other achievements</li> </ol>
SUBMISSION PROCESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>EOI applications are limited to 1 page (application) and 2 page CV (track record)</li> <li>Applications must be 12 point font, double spaced and 2cm margin</li> <li>Applications are to be submitted in PDF format, as a single document</li> <li>The EOI application must be submitted as an email attachment to <a href="mailto:rcccp@griffith.edu.au">rcccp@griffith.edu.au</a>, clearly marked in the subject line: EOI for publication workshop by COB <b>16 May 2011</b>(deadline)</li> <li>No extensions to the deadline will be granted</li> <li>Applications will be acknowledged by return email</li> </ul> <p>Incomplete or late applications will not be considered by the panel</p>
SELECTION PROCESS	<p>Applications will be considered confidentially by the following panel:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Director (Chair)</i></li> <li><i>Deputy Director</i></li> <li><i>Unit Leaders</i></li> </ul> <p>The selection panel will be supported by the RCCCPi Administrative Manager. All applicants will be advised of the outcomes of the selection process by email.</p>
REPORTING OUTCOMES	Successful applicants must agree to report on submission of publication written at workshop and on success on submission process.
