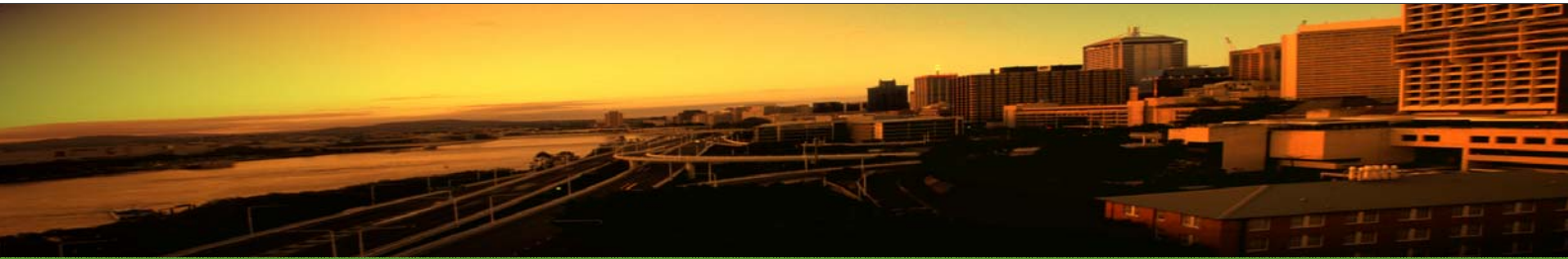

Seminar Summary:

John Pucher examines three important public health concerns: traffic safety, environmental quality, and physical exercise. Walking and cycling integrate good health and good transport. Both make urban transport safer and less polluting while generating valuable cardiovascular exercise as part of everyday transport routine.

Presenter Biography:

JOHN PUCHER is a professor in the Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy at Rutgers University (New Brunswick, New Jersey). He is currently a visiting professor at the University of Sydney. Since earning a Ph.D. at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1978, Pucher has conducted research for the U.S. Department of Transportation, the Canadian government, and various European ministries of transport.
