Smart drivers

A DESIRE to reduce the road toll while increasing society's mobility is the driving force behind Griffith University research into driverless vehicle technology. In a free public lecture next week, Professor Ljubo Vlacic will present his research in the field of control engineering and autonomous, driverless vehicles. "A zero road toll can only be achieved if human drivers are replaced by extremely reliable and fatigue-free intelligent machines," Professor Vlacic said. "At Griffith's Intelligent Control Systems Laboratory we are developing smart sensors, electronics and control and decision making algorithms to give vehicles and robots intelligence to make their own decisions."
