

Workshops for Casual Academic Staff New to Teaching

Casual academic staff are key members of the University's academic community and perform a vital role in learning and teaching activities at Griffith. If you are a casual academic staff member new to teaching in higher education, this workshop provides an essential orientation to learning and teaching at Griffith. To enhance your teaching experience, the University requires all new casual academic staff attend this four-hour workshop, or an equivalent program offered by your School or Faculty. This workshop will offer:

- an overview of learning and teaching priorities at Griffith;
- an introduction to teaching and learning in higher education;
- strategies to enhance student learning and engagement in large classes and small groups, including tips for managing diverse student cohorts;
- practical ideas for assessing student learning and seeking and providing feedback.

This is a valuable opportunity to meet other Griffith Colleagues, learn from a panel of more experienced casual academic staff who will share hints and tips, and collect useful resources to guide you in your teaching. Casual academic staff who attend one of these workshops will receive a statement of participation from the GIHE and will be entitled to payment commensurate with teaching duties from the Schools.
