

BASIL JONES ORCHESTRAL HALL (Room 1.82, Level 1)

This is an ideal performance venue for small concerts and rehearsals. It is also an excellent venue for functions, and caters for up to 300 people standing.

The venue contains the Owen Fletcher Pipe Organ (available for use in certain circumstances). Please contact Venue Operations for specifications.

Seating Capacity

Up to 120 free standing chairs depending on performance requirements

Stage Dimensions

Total area is 250sq m inclusive of audience and performance areas.

Acoustics

The Basil Jones Orchestral Hall contains the same type of acoustic paneling that is found on the stage of the Conservatorium Theatre. It is a venue with a bright sound that can be dampened by the adjustable acoustic panels and by use of the large curtain installed on the Grey Street wall.

Dressing Rooms

There are no special provisions for a dressing room when hiring the Basil Jones Orchestral Hall. If required, please contact the Venue Operations Office to arrange access to the Conservatorium Theatre dressing rooms if available.

Staffing

A minimum of one Front of House staff member (a Duty Manager) is required for the Basil Jones Orchestral Hall. If tickets are being sold through Qtix there will be the additional need for a Box Office Manager. Crew are required for setting up the venue on each occasion, and Lighting Operators and Audio-Visual/Sound staff may be required.

Facilities Included

Air conditioning, one clean per day, standard house lighting, use of a grand piano, music stands and orchestra chairs as available, rostra, portafloor and other stage stock material (as available), access to the Loading Dock and standard Building Security staff during normal building hours, Monday to Friday 7am to 10pm, Saturday and Sunday 8am to 6pm.
