



## Australian Rivers Institute PhD Scholarship

A PhD scholarship is available to work in Griffith University's Ancient DNA laboratory with Professor David Lambert (Nathan campus).

### **Project aims:**

Projects covering a range of evolutionary topics are available. Potential study organisms include Adélie penguins in Antarctica (some field work is likely), as well as moa and tuatara of New Zealand.

### **Requirements:** The successful applicant will have

- BSc (Hons 1 or 2A) or Masters Degree related to the PhD project aims
- a strong research record
- excellent communication skills, and
- fieldwork experience.

### **Scholarship value:** AUD\$25,000 per annum for 3 years.

Higher Degree Research students in the Institute also have access to research laboratories, field equipment (inc 4WDs), higher degree research training and access to excellent water science researchers.

Operational expenses can be negotiated between the successful candidate and Professor Lambert.
