Graduate Certificate in Sustainable Enterprise

Admission requirements:	To be eligible for admission you must: <ul style="list-style-type: none">→ hold a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognised University (or other tertiary education institution of equivalent standing) with a minimum grade point average of 4.5 (using a 7.0 point scale) and have a minimum of three years relevant equivalent full-time work experience post-degree including two years equivalent full-time in a management or supervisory level position in a business environment; OR→ have a minimum of seven years equivalent full-time work experience including two years in a management or supervisory level in a business environment (such students will be admitted at the discretion of the Program Director). Degrees from overseas institutions must be assessed as being equivalent to a recognised Australian bachelor's level degree.
Application closing date:	Applications close on 31 January for semester one and 30 June for semester two annually.
