Local sustainable development — examples from Austria —

The design of sustainable development at the local level (cf. Local Agenda 21 & local energy planning in Austria) is discussed. Three case studies are presented: a role model for Local Agenda 21, a wind farm involving 100 people and a biomass district heating system for 160 farmers. The importance of both vision and ecological footprinting is argued.

Gernot Stöglehner is a landscape planner and environmental engineer. He is a lecturer at the BOKU-University Vienna, Austria. His research interests are sustainable spatial planning & development and environmental planning & assessment. Gernot holds a visiting position at Griffith University.
