Strategies for study at university (2 hrs)

An introduction to university culture and expectations. Focuses on strategies for managing your time and studying effectively.

Getting started on your assignment (2 hrs)

Approach your uni assignments with confidence. Covers interpreting the assignment question, planning an assignment and more.

Get ready to research (1½ hrs)

Gain an awareness of the wide range of information resources available at Griffith.

Reading and note taking (2 hrs)

Looks at how to identify different purposes and appropriate strategies for reading and note taking effectively.

Basic computing survival skills (3 hrs)*

New to computers? This workshop is aimed at absolute beginners with little or no computing experience. Learn about how a computer works, understand computing terminology, and explore the Microsoft Windows environment.

Introduction to Griffith's online environment (3 hrs)*

New to Griffith University? This introductory workshop will help you to become familiar with Griffith's intranet and internet environments and includes accessing the Griffith Portal, Learning@Griffith, Internet access, using your Griffith email account and more. Includes demonstrations of software skills that are particularly relevant for academic writing, along with information on how to gain those skills.
