

**FACULTY OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES
LEN DINGWELL TRAVELLING BURSARY
2009 CONDITIONS OF AWARD**

1.0 Purpose

The Len Dingwell Travelling Bursary is available to research higher degree candidates enrolled in the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. The bursary will support international travel to a library/archive/research centre for the purpose of undertaking work directly related to the candidate's research project. It is expected that this travel will also allow students to build networks with experts in their field.

2.0 Application Procedure

RHD candidates wishing to apply for the bursary should complete the form 'Application for Griffith University Len Dingwell Travelling Bursary' and submit it to the Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences by Friday, 27 March 2009. 3.0 Selection Process and Timing

Applications will be accepted by the closing date and will be individually assessed by the Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences on the recommendation of an applicant's principal supervisor and Head of School. The Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences will have the executive authority to award the bursary.

4.0 Eligibility

The bursary will be available only to those who are an enrolled and confirmed PhD candidate in the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences at Griffith University.

5.0 Ineligibility

RHD candidates are not eligible for a Len Dingwell Travelling Bursary if the applicant

- 5.1 has previously received a Len Dingwell Travelling Bursary;
- 5.2 is a Griffith University staff member;
- 5.3 is an academic staff member at another tertiary institution;
- 5.4 is enrolled in a PhD by Publication degree program.

6.0 Value and Payment of Bursary

- 6.1 The value of the bursary is \$5000.
- 6.2 The bursary will be paid either by cheque or EFT.
- 6.3 The bursary will be presented to the recipient at the Prizes and Awards function.

7.0 Commencement of Bursary

The bursary will commence on the date of award and will be valid for a period of 12 months from that date.

8.0 Bursary Holder Obligations

- 8.1 Payment of the bursary is subject to the recipient's attendance at the Prizes and Awards function. The recipient is also required to attend a lunch with the sponsor and the Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences.
- 8.2 A holder of the Len Dingwell Travelling Bursary is required to conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times while representing the University at overseas institutions.

- 8.3 The recipient of the Len Dingwell Travelling Bursary is required to provide a brief report on the outcomes of the research travel to the Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences within one month of returning from the trip.
- 8.4 A holder of the Len Dingwell Travelling Bursary is required to notify the University in writing if the bursary holder:
- discontinues studies;
 - is granted a scholarship or any other bursary or similar award for a course of postgraduate study.

Applications are now invited and should be submitted to the Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences by Friday, 27 March 2009.
