The workshop theme, Improvements for Patient Recovery After Intensive Care reflects the importance of ICU patient recovery research. The 2nd International ICU Recovery Workshop for Early Career Researchers will provide an important forum for knowledge exchange in relation to both methodological and content issues, and provide the opportunity for researchers to collaborate with other researchers in similar field internationally.
