



The Justice Michael Kirby Award: Nomination Form

The Justice Michael Kirby Award will be presented annually from 2008 to a Griffith law student or law alumnus who has made an outstanding contribution to queer issues either through the production of a piece of scholarly work or through their involvement in the queer community. In evaluating a nominee's suitability for the award the selection committee will look specifically for scholarly work or community contribution that furthers the principles of acceptance, diversity and inclusiveness as espoused by Justice Kirby in relation to gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender and intersex issues. The contribution of the nominee - whether scholarly or service-related, must have taken place in the twelve months prior to November 2008. The value of the award is \$500.00.
