

**THE GRIFFITH BUSINESS SCHOOL INDIGENOUS SCHOLARSHIP**

The Griffith Business School offers innovative programs in a diverse range of areas including international business, Asian studies, employment relations, event management, tourism, financial planning, human resources, marketing, politics, sport management, and real estate and property development.

The Griffith Business School Indigenous Scholarship is available to Indigenous Australians in order to support them with their studies. The scholarship has been established to encourage the participation of Indigenous Australians in Business, Commerce and related degree programs.

These Scholarships are available to commencing students, valued at \$15 000 each, over 3 years. Each scholarship is broken down into \$5000 per year (two payments per year, paid after each census date). Payments will be made into the recipient's nominated bank account each semester, providing the recipient meets the minimum GPA requirements each semester.

**SELECTION CRITERIA**

To be eligible for the Scholarship, a candidate must satisfy the following criteria:

- have been offered and have accepted a place in a Griffith Business School program
- must demonstrate the ability to succeed at University
- must provide a personal statement outlining how the scholarship would benefit your studies at University
- proof of Indigeneity signed by Community Elder or Leader
- must meet GPA requirements each semester in order to retain the scholarship.

The Scholarship is available to commencing students only.

To remain eligible for the scholarship, applicants will be required to:

- maintain a GPA of 4.5 or above for the duration of the Scholarship benefit
- be enrolled on a full-time basis (unless extenuating circumstances exist); and
- remain a student of Griffith Business School for the duration of the scholarship.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING**

1. Complete Section 1 - Personal details.
  2. Section 2 - Personal Statement: Write a personal statement of no more than 500 words outlining how the Scholarship would benefit you and how you would utilise the funds.
  3. Sign and date the Declaration and include signed proof of Indigeneity.
- Applicants will be notified within of receipt of the application by the Undergraduate Scholarships Office via the email address provided by the applicant.
  - Short listed applicants may be required to attend an interview for selection process. The committee will contact short listed applicants to arrange a time.
  - Applicants will be notified about the outcome of their application via their mailing address and/or email address as advised on their application form.
