## Griffith Journal of the Environment Contributor's Publication Agreement

Griffith Journal of the Environment (GJE) is intended to provide an opportunity for postgraduate students, advanced study students and academics to publish high quality output as a demonstration of their achievement in interdisciplinary research. GJE papers are intended to be interdisciplinary and collaborative in the areas of environmental studies encompassing science, planning, policy, engineering, law and any other area of research that may be relevant.

We invite you to submit a research article, a short report or a review (see Contributors Notes) for review and possible inclusion in an upcoming issue of the Griffith Journal of the Environment.

**Contributions must be original works which have neither been previously published nor submitted to, and currently under consideration by, another publication. If the article is submitted to another journal, subsequent to its submission to the GJE, the author will immediately advise the GJE Editor who will withdraw the article from consideration by the GJE. Contributions will not be considered unless a signed copy of this Agreement is attached.**

Research papers will be independently refereed by at least two external peers before publication. The contributor[s] are encouraged to nominate up to two referees with their submission (who may include members of the editorial board), to undertake the review process. While contributors are not required to do so, nomination of referees may lead to quicker acceptance and publication. There is no obligation on the editors and editorial panel to use the referees nominated and the editorial decision based on the reviews shall be final. The contributors must acknowledge acceptance of each page of the proof which will be provided in PDF format via email prior to the document being published. The Issue will be online once all articles have been peer and/or editorially reviewed.

Contributors must comply with the requirements of the GJE as stated in the 'Contributors Notes'. Spelling should conform to the Macquarie Dictionary: Australia's National Dictionary, Revised Third Edition (Delbridge et al eds 1997). For style, authors should be guided by the recommendations in the Style manual: For authors, editors and printers, sixth edition (Snooks & Co. eds 2002).

Upon being accepted for publication, the author agrees to the following:

1. Copyright is vested in the GJE and in each author to his or her contribution.
2. The GJE reserves the right to make editorial changes to manuscripts accepted for publication. The GJE reserves the right to delay publication of any manuscript at any time.
3. It is a condition of publication that the author assigns to Griffith University and other education and non-profit institutions a non-exclusive licence to use this document for personal use and in courses of instruction provided that the article is used in full and this copyright statement is reproduced.
4. The author grants a non-exclusive licence to Griffith University to publish this article in full on the World Wide Web, including on the GJE website, and in printed form.
5. The author certifies that the material they present is their own or that they have permission to use that which they are quoting.
6. The author may post the article, in its final accepted form, on their personal server or on their institution's eprint server. However, authors must create a link to the published article. The link must be accompanied by the following text: "The original article has been published in the *Griffith Journal of The Environment*, (year, issue number, page number), the only accredited archive of the content that has been certified and accepted after peer review. Copyright and all rights therein are retained by the GJE and the author".
