

# Student FAQ

# Can I apply to study at Griffith after successfully completing Bridging English?

Griffith Bridging English (GBE) satisfies the English Subject Prerequisite for all Griffith University undergraduate programs. Note: GBE does not satisfy English Language Proficiency.

GBE students wishing to apply to study an undergraduate program must also meet all other admission requirements for their chosen program as published on the <u>Degree Finder</u> such as minimum selection rank, other prerequisites, English Proficiency, and any additional selection criteria.

#### Do I have to attend all tutorials?

The course is a 7-week intensive program and attendance at all tutorials and completion of all online modules, tasks and assessments are compulsory.

## How much time do I need to allocate to GBE?

You will need to allow 13 – 15 hours per week to complete your online modules, tasks and assessments in addition to the weekly 3-hour on-campus tutorial.

### When do I get my results?

Generally, results are released within 21 days after course completion as follows:

You will need to ensure that the results will be available for the offer round/trimester in which you wish to apply for admission with Griffith.

# Do I have to apply to study at Griffith through QTAC? What do I do next?

For admission to Griffith University you will need to apply via the Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC). An application fee applies and will vary depending on the date of the application and whether you are a School Leaver or Mature applicant. You do not need to wait till you have completed the course and can even apply prior to commencing.

Mature students who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander may be eligible to apply via Direct Admission. For more information visit GUMURRII Student Success Apply to study.



# What if I have already applied via QTAC?

If you have a current QTAC application before enrolling in GBE, email your QTAC details to <a href="mailto:griffith-english@griffith.edu.au">griffith-english@griffith.edu.au</a>. If you have a QTAC application and a Griffith preference, then Domestic Admissions can search records and update your application with your results for the English prerequisite once completed.

## When should I lodge my application to study at Griffith via QTAC?

If you are ready to commence your studies and/or confident you meet all other the admission requirements, you can apply before or after completing the course. You will have the option of listing up to 6 preferences on your QTAC application. We do however encourage you to apply as soon as possible to ensure that other aspects of your application may be assessed. Please also refer to the QTAC website for any document due dates or other requirements for admission.

### I am a current Year 12 student, is this course suitable for me?

As the course is taught in intensive mode it is not suitable for a Year 12 student. There is however a November offering that may be suitable for Year 12's interested in applying for the March intake the following year. Please ensure that you refer to the <a href="School Leaver English Enhancement">School Leaver English Enhancement</a> course first should you be eligible for this offering.
