

Griffith Sport Toohey Trail Run Terms and Conditions

WARNING THIS IS A LEGAL DOCUMENT AND MAY EFFECT YOUR RIGHTS PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Entries in the Griffith Sport Toohey Trail Run are to be completed online. Individual entries will close at 6:00am on Sunday 9th October 2022. Team entries must be finalised by 11:59pm Sunday 2nd October 2022. Griffith University reserve the right to close off online registration at their discretion should the event reach capacity entrant numbers. On-the-day entries may not be available.
2. For an entry to be valid, all entrants must complete the online entry form and pay the required entry fee prior to the commencement of the event. All entrants must wear the official race bib at all times during the running portions of the event. Entry is only valid for the details listed on the entry form and is transferable until five days prior to the event.
3. Team members will only receive the team rate when registering (a) the minimum number of 4 team members to create the team and (b) when registering as part of an already established team containing 4 or more entrants
4. Entrants must remain on the designated course as marked by race officials and course signage.
5. Events will be timed at the finish line by a professional timing company, with timing chips attached to each entrants race bib. It is the participants' responsibility to ensure they have their race bib on at all times, including when they cross the finish line, to ensure they receive their individual time.
6. Line honours will determine the first, second & third place of each category.
7. By agreeing to these terms and conditions, entrants release Griffith University and all other event organisers, from all claims connected with participation. Entrants indemnify Griffith University and all others involved in this event directly or indirectly against all liability for any and all injury, loss or damage connected with the entrant's participation.
8. All entrants accept that participation in this event is at their own risk and they accept that participating in this event may involve real risk of injury including but not limited to: over exertion, dehydration and accidents with other participants, spectators or pedestrians.
9. If you are registering on behalf of your family you accept these terms and conditions on behalf of all family members competing.
10. All entrants declare that they are physically fit and capable of participating in this event. They are not aware of any medical condition or impairment that will prevent participation in this event or will affect their health by participation. If an entrant becomes aware of any such condition or impairment or they are injured or sick prior to the event, they have the opportunity to withdraw. All entrants will provide Griffith University the details of any medical or other condition that may be relevant should medical treatment be required or may affect their participation in the event.
11. Each entrant agrees to abide by any advice given by the event medical officers regarding their health and consent to receive and pay for any medical treatment, including transport by ambulance, required before, during or after the event.
12. Race officials have the ultimate authority to remove a competitor from the race if the competitor is judged to be incapable of continuing the race without risk of serious injury.
13. Before agreeing to the Terms and Conditions, each participant needs to read the official Cut Off Policy. Race officials reserve the right to remove any participant from the course should they not meet the conditions outlined in this policy.
14. Race Officials have the right to remove any competitors without a visible race bib from the course without warning.
15. Entrants acknowledge that should they withdraw or should the event be cancelled or changed due to reasons beyond the control of Griffith University such as safety reasons, Queensland Health directives or poor weather conditions, the entry fee is non-refundable.

16. Entrants consent to the use of their name, image, photographs, video and comments in any publications and marketing in relation to this event by Griffith University.
17. All entrants must walk or run without the assistance of bikes, skateboards rip sticks, rollerblades or similar items, which are prohibited for safety reasons.
18. No pets are allowed on the course. Guide dogs are permitted.
19. Prizes will be awarded to valid entrants crossing the finish line in the designated categories and finishing positions detailed in these terms and conditions. If the prize winner is ineligible, the entrant will forfeit their prize.
20. Griffith University reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entrant which, in the reasonable opinion of the Event Organiser, engaged in conduct in entering which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Event.
21. Good sportsmanlike conduct will be demanded of all competitors, any unsportsmanlike conduct will be grounds for instant disqualification.
22. All entrants accept that Griffith University's decision is final and that no correspondence will be entered into. Entrants consent to follow all directions by event organisers in relation to this event.
23. Griffith Sport understands that gender diversity refers to a diverse range of gender expressions and identities and welcomes all persons to Griffith Sport events. Griffith Sport does recognise gender divisions endorsed by National Sporting Organisations, which may be as follows
 - Male: participation is restricted to those who identify as male
 - Female: participation is restricted to those who identify as female
24. Griffith Sport also follows the Sex and Gender Classification in accordance to the [Australian Government Guidelines on the Recognition of Sex and Gender](#). Gender X (Indeterminate/Intersex/Unspecified) is available for those individuals who do not exclusively identify as either male or female i.e. a person of a non-binary gender. There must be a minimum of 5 entrants registered per category for prize category to be awarded.
