

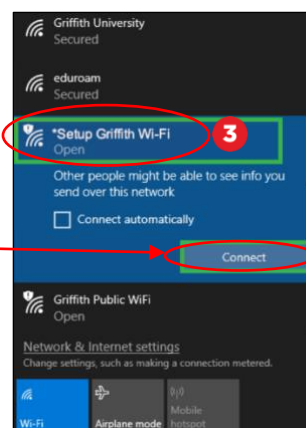
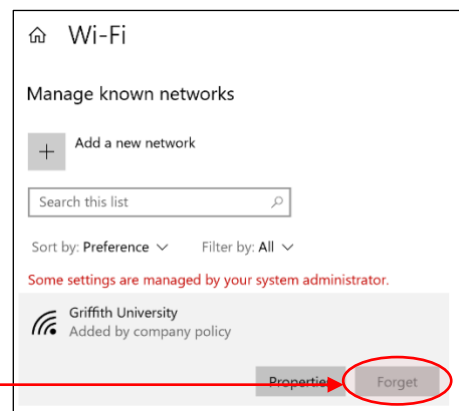
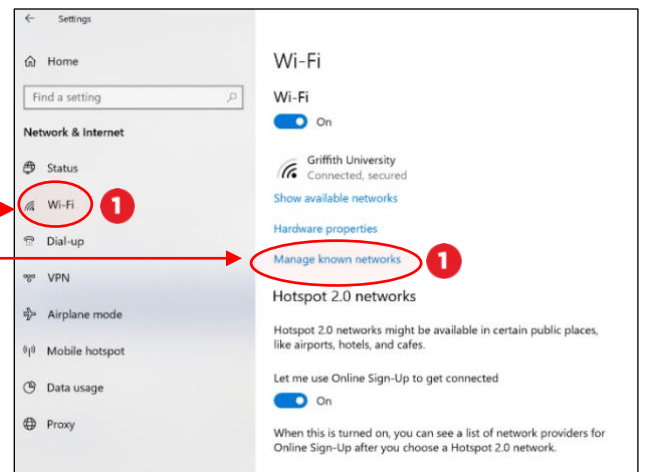
## Introduction

This guide will show you how to connect to Griffith University (Griffith) Wi-Fi on Windows 10.

## Step 1: Remove the existing Griffith Wi-Fi network on your device

- This step **must** be completed, or the setup process will fail. If you have never connected before, skip to **Step 2**.

- 1 Go to **Network Settings**, then **Wi-Fi** and **Manage known networks**.
- 2 Select **Forget** on the Griffith University network.
- 3 Select **\*Setup Griffith Wi-Fi** and then **Connect**.



## Step 2: Connect to Griffith Wi-Fi

1 Open a web browser and go to [wifi.griffith.edu.au](http://wifi.griffith.edu.au).



2 Select **Join Now**.

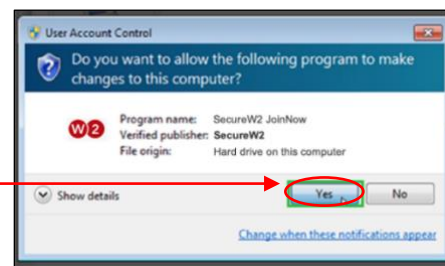
The software will automatically detect the type of device you are using (Windows 10). If the device detected is incorrect, select your device from the **drop-down list** and select **Join Now**.



3 Select **Run** when prompted to download the application as an .exe file.

4 Select **Yes** if prompted to allow SecureW2 app to make changes to your device (note some machines may skip this step).

5 Select **Next**.



## Step 3: Authenticate and complete Wi-Fi setup

- 1 Enter your Griffith credentials and select **Login**.
- 2 Enter your Griffith username followed by **@griffith.edu.au**, then your password and select **Next**.
- 3 Select **Done**.
- 4 Go back into your **Network settings**, select **Wi-Fi** and then select **Griffith University** as your preferred network (it may take up to one minute for the network to appear).
- 5 Close all setup browsers. You can now use the Griffith University Wi-Fi network. You may still be prompted to log into your internet access account when browsing the internet. Login at <https://ias.griffith.edu.au/griffith/portal/login>.
