

Introduction

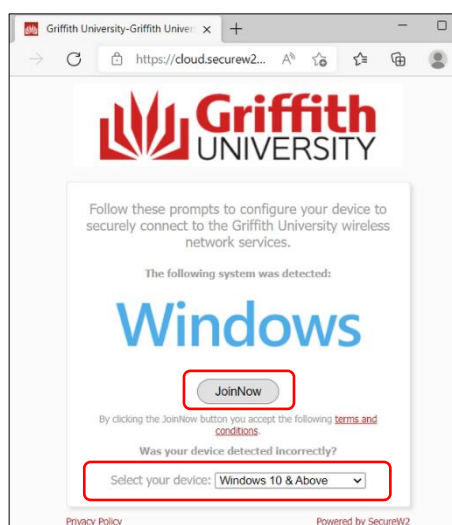
This guide will show you how to connect to Griffith University Wi-Fi network on a Windows 10 (or above) device.

Before you start – The onboarding process requires an active internet connection. If you are on campus and require temporary access, connect to the **Setup Griffith WiFi* SSID.

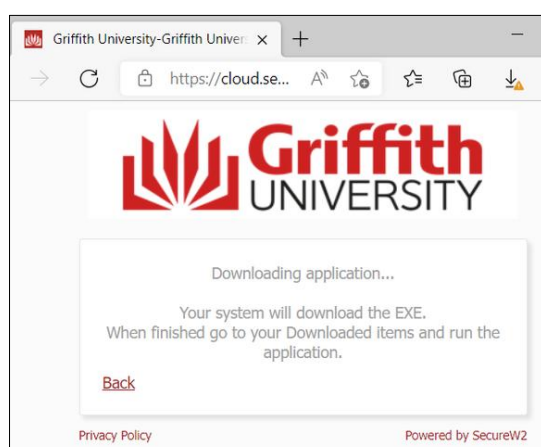
Screenshots in this guide may differ depending on device and software versions.

Part A: Download and set up SecureW2 JoinNow

- 1 Open an internet browser and go to **wifi.griffith.edu.au**.
- 2 Check **Select your device** is set to **Windows 10 & Above**. Click **JoinNow**.



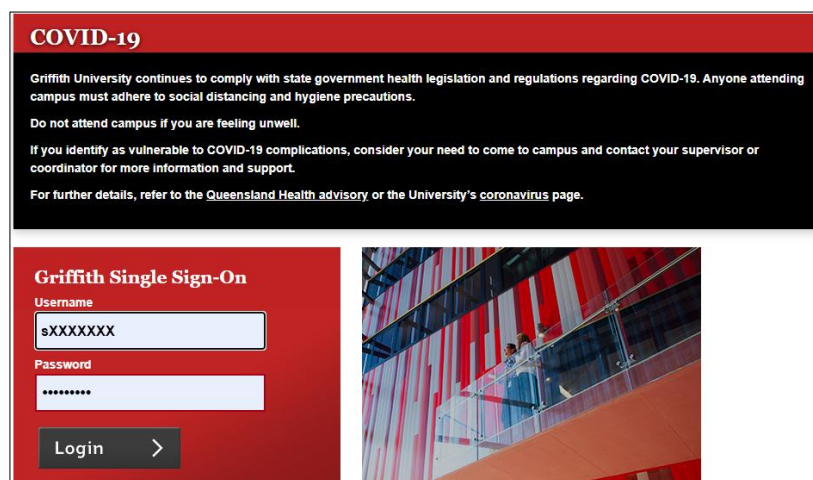
- 3 The **WiFi_Griffith_University_Wrapper.exe** file will download to your device. For some devices, you may be prompted to allow (or keep) the download.



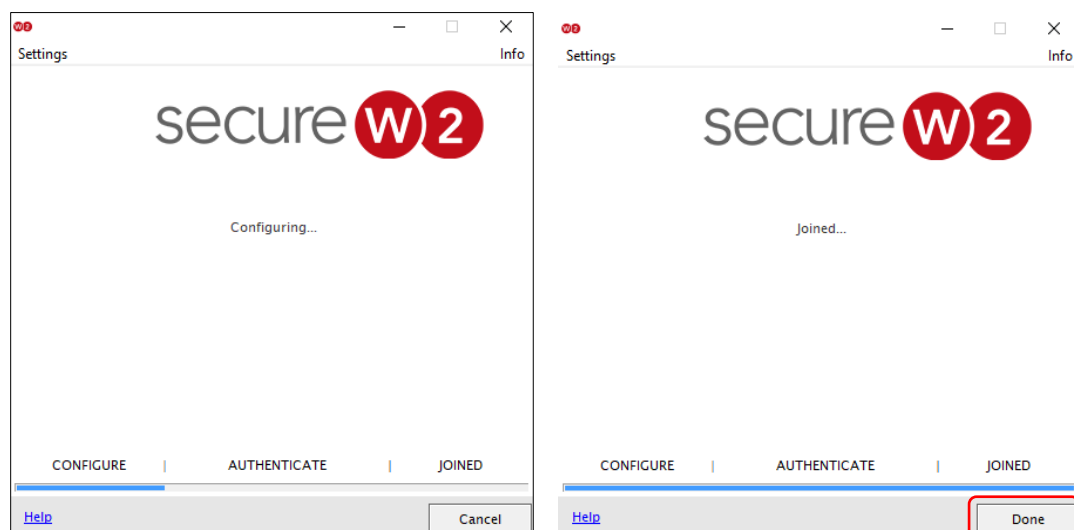
- 4 Once downloaded, open the file to begin the setup process. If prompted to allow SecureW2 to make changes to your device, select **Yes**.
- 5 Select **Next** to be taken to the sign in screen.



- 6 Sign in with your **Griffith sNumber** and **Griffith password** (e.g sXXXXXXX).



- 7 Once the SecureW2 setup has finished click **Done**.



Part B: Test Wi-Fi connection

- 1 Open the **Wi-Fi** menu on your desktop and check your device is now connected to the **Griffith University** Wi-Fi network (it may take up to one minute for the network to appear).
