

Introduction

This guide will show you how to connect to Griffith University Wi-Fi on a Huawei device.

Before you start - You must be on campus to complete the steps in this guide. You also need to close all applications using Wi-Fi/Internet before attempting the steps in this guide (including Outlook and Microsoft 365).


Screenshots in this guide may differ depending on device and software versions.

Have you connected to Griffith Wi-Fi or Eduroam from your device before?

No - Continue to Section 1: Connect to *Setup Griffith Wi-Fi.

Yes – You will need to uninstall the SecureW2 JoinNow app from your device and forget the **Griffith University** and **Eduroam** Wi-Fi networks.

- Open the Google Play store on your device and uninstall the SecureW2 JoinNow app.
- Open the Wi-Fi menu on your device. Tap on Griffith University then select Forget.



3 Repeat the same as above for the Eduroam Wi-Fi network, then continue to Part A: Connect to *Setup Griffith Wi-Fi.

Part A: Connect to *Setup Griffith Wi-Fi


1 From the Wi-Fi menu on your device, select *Setup Griffith Wi-Fi and wait for your device to connect.





Part B: Download the SecureW2 JoinNow app

① Open a web browser and go to wifi.griffith.edu.au




2 Select Google Play Store (App) from the drop-down list and tap Download.

Some devices will default to the Huawei AppGallery for download. You must select the Google Play Store as the SecureW2 app is only available there.



Tap Install. Once the SecureW2 JoinNow app has installed tap Open and continue to Part C: Set up the SecureW2 JoinNow app.








If you are unable to open to SecureW2 JoinNow app:

Open your web browser and go to wifi.griffith.edu.au.




2 Click JoinNow.



For Android 9 or above devices, the below prompt will display. Select I Understand. (If your device is not Android 9 or above, go to Step 6).




Select **Yes, allow location**. If you do not select yes during the setup process, you will need to manually connect your Wi-Fi.






Select your preference to Allow all the time or Allow only while using the app.



6 You may also be asked to turn on location services for a better experience. Select your preference.



Part C: Set up the SecureW2 JoinNow app

1 At the below prompt click **Next**.



2 Sign in using your **Griffith sNumber** and Griffith password (e.g. sXXXXXXX).





Enter your sNumber followed by @griffith.edu.au (e.g. sXXXXXXX@griffith.edu.au) and your Griffith University password then tap Continue.



4 Select Done.



Part D: Test your Wi-Fi connection

Open **Wi-Fi Settings** and check your device is now connected to the **Griffith University** Wi-Fi network. (It may take up to one minute for the network to appear)



2 Once connected, try browsing the internet to check your connection to Griffith University Wi-Fi is working correctly.
