



New Colombo Plan Scholarship Program for Undergraduates

Expression of Interest Closes 4pm on Monday 24 May 2021

What is it?

The New Colombo Plan (NCP), launched in 2014, aims to lift knowledge in Australia of the Indo-Pacific by supporting Australian undergraduates to study and undertake internships in the region.

The NCP Scholarship Program provides around 120 Scholarships annually to a diverse range of Australian undergraduates studying a range of disciplines in up to 40 Indo-Pacific locations. Scholars are encouraged to undertake study, Language Training and an Internship and/or Mentorship for up to 19 months.

Who should apply?

To be eligible for a New Colombo Plan (NCP) Scholarship, and to remain eligible during the Scholarship Program if a Scholarship is awarded, applicants must:

- have been nominated for the NCP Scholarship Program by their Home University;
- be an Australian citizen;
- not be a current or previous citizen or permanent resident of their Primary Location or any Secondary Location;
- be enrolled, until completion of all Study Components, in at least one Bachelor Degree or Bachelor Honours Degree unit at an on-shore campus of an Australian University;
- be undertaking, until completion of all Study Components, at least one Bachelor Degree or Bachelor Honours Degree;
- be between 18–30 years for non-Indigenous students and to 35 years for Indigenous students;
- have achieved a minimum 70 per cent graded average or equivalent for their undergraduate course at the time of Application, as determined by the nominating Home University; and
- not be a previous recipient of a Scholarship under the NCP Scholarship Program

How to apply?

Each Australian University may nominate up to ten (10) Applicants for the 2022 round of the NCP Scholarship Program. Griffith University hold an internal Expression of Interest which is a competitive process to select the 2022 nominees.

The internal process to select Griffith University nominees is competitive process, take time with your expression of interest, seek advice from [Griffith Go Global](#) and read widely about the scholarship program and your intended host location.
