

Allied Health Students undertaking a clinical placement in a Queensland Government Hospital and Health Service need to complete a number of [training modules](#) prior to commencement of their placement.

How do I complete the Queensland Health Allied Health Online Training?

1. Download the [Allied Health student training: A guide for students](#) which details the responsibilities of all parties involved in the provision of training for placement.
2. Register on [iLearn](#) as some of the modules are completed via this online learning platform. Complete your registration on iLearn **before** accessing the student orientation modules. It may take at least 3 working days for your registration to be completed. For more information download the [iLearn user help for students](#).
3. Download the [Record of Allied Health Student Training](#). A completed copy is to be presented to each Queensland Government Hospital and Health Service placement site at **the commencement of each placement**.
4. Click on [Clinical placement information for allied health students](#) to move to the next web page.
5. Follow the Steps on how to access the modules.

Step 1: Complete modules on iLearn platform

Step 2: Complete the [Mandatory training modules](#) for allied health students.

Step 3: Complete your [Record of Allied Health Student Training](#) form and keep this up to date as you complete each module

Step 4: Submit your Record of Allied Health Student Training form in SONIA. Don't forget to present on the commencement of your placement.

Step 5: Remain up to date with the modules required to be completed annually.

What do I upload onto SONIA?

Upload a copy of your completed Record of Allied Health Student Training form.
