

Ordering your preferences

Year 12 Early Offer Guarantee

In order to receive an early offer in November, you must meet the requirements for the scheme and have one of the approved Early Offer Guarantee degrees listed as your highest eligible QTAC preference.

Starting in Trimester 3, 2020

To commence study in **Trimester 3, 2020** you must list the **November 2020** offering of an approved Year 12 Early Offer Guarantee degree above any later offerings or any degrees that are not approved as part of the Year 12 Early Offer Guarantee scheme.

Let's assume you are applying for an early offer into the Bachelor of Business for Trimester 3. Below are examples of how to, and how not to, order your preferences.

Preference	Degree	Offering
1	Bachelor of Business	NOV 20
2	Bachelor of Business	MAR 21
3	Bachelor of Arts	MAR 21

Having the Bachelor of Business NOV 20 offering as your highest eligible preference will ensure you can be made an early offer for Trimester 3, 2020.

Preference	Degree	Offering
1	Bachelor of Business	MAR 21
2	Bachelor of Business	NOV 20
3	Bachelor of Arts	MAR 21

Your NOV 20 preference must be above any MAR 21 preferences to receive a Trimester 3, 2020 offer. If you preference like this example you will receive an early offer but it will be to start in Trimester 1, 2021.

Preference	Degree	Offering
1	Bachelor of Laws (Honours)	NOV 20
2	Bachelor of Business	NOV 20
3	Bachelor of Arts	MAR 21

If you list a degree that is not part of the Year 12 Early Offer Guarantee scheme, eg the Bachelor of Laws (Honours), or a degree that you are not eligible for above a degree that is approved under the scheme you won't receive an early offer. If you preference like this example you would be considered for a place in the Bachelor of Arts for Trimester 1, 2021 in the QTAC offer rounds in December and January after your Year 12 results are released.

Starting in Trimester 1, 2021

To commence study in **Trimester 1, 2021** you must list the **March 2021** offering of an approved Year 12 Early Offer Guarantee degree above any later offerings or any degrees that are not approved as part of the Year 12 Early Offer Guarantee scheme.

Let's assume you are applying for an early offer into the Bachelor of Business for Trimester 1. Below are examples of how to, and how not to, order your preferences.

Preference	Degree	Offering
1	Bachelor of Business	MAR 21
2	Bachelor of Arts	MAR 21
3	Bachelor of Business	JUL 21

Having the Bachelor of Business MAR 21 offering as your highest eligible preference will ensure you can be made an early offer for Trimester 1, 2021.

Preference	Degree	Offering
1	Bachelor of Business	JUL 21
2	Bachelor of Business	MAR 21
3	Bachelor of Arts	MAR 21

Your MAR 21 preference must be above any JUL 21 preferences to receive a Trimester 1, 2021 offer. If you preference like this example you won't receive an early offer. Instead, you would be considered for a place in the Bachelor of Business for Trimester 2, 2021 in the QTAC offer rounds in December and January after your Year 12 results are released.

Preference	Degree	Offering
1	Bachelor of Medical Science	MAR 21
2	Bachelor of Business	MAR 21
3	Bachelor of Arts	MAR 21

If you list a degree that is not part of the Year 12 Early Offer Guarantee scheme, eg the Bachelor of Medical Science, or a degree that you are not eligible for above a degree that is approved under the scheme you won't receive an early offer. If you preference like this example you would be considered for a place in the Bachelor of Medical Science for Trimester 1, 2021 in the QTAC offer round in January after your Year 12 results are released. If you did not receive an offer into the Bachelor of Medical Science you would be considered for a place in the Bachelor of Business in the January offer round.
