



Making the most of your preferences

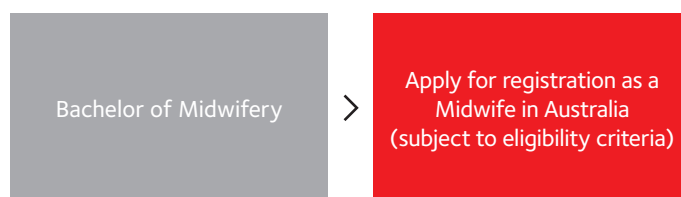
Bachelor of Midwifery

It is important to make the best use of your preference list by including alternative programs that can provide a pathway to your preferred program.

If you are interested in a career in Midwifery the most direct route is via the Bachelor of Midwifery, however competition for limited places means that talented applicants miss out every year.

By studying an alternative program for one year and achieving a high GPA, you may increase your admission rank to be competitive for an offer into the Bachelor of Midwifery. This can be achieved through alternative programs from any discipline, however recommended options include the Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Biomedical Science and Bachelor of Health Science.

Once you have completed 80CP in a bachelor program at Griffith, if you still wish to study the Bachelor of Midwifery you can apply for an internal transfer.



Alternative pathways to the Bachelor of Midwifery:

- ▶ Bachelor of Nursing
- ▶ Bachelor of Biomedical Science
- ▶ Bachelor of Health Science
- ▶ Another undergraduate program.

Admission via these programs is subject to meeting eligibility criteria.

Preferencing examples

Applicant A

Received OP 5

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their second preference. They could conditionally accept this offer and wait to be considered for a higher preference in the later offer rounds. If they don't receive an offer into a higher preference, they can accept their offer into the Bachelor of Social Work as a pathway to the Bachelor of Midwifery.

Note. 2018 minimum OP used as an example only.

1. Bachelor of Midwifery – GU – Logan and Gold Coast
2. Bachelor of Social Work – GU – Logan
3. Bachelor of Health Science – GU – Gold Coast
4. Bachelor of Human Services – GU – Logan

6. Bachelor of Arts – GU – Gold Coast

Applicant B

Received OP 12

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their third preference. They could conditionally accept this offer and wait to be considered for a higher preference in the later offer rounds. If they don't receive an offer into a higher preference, they can accept their offer into the Bachelor of Nursing as a pathway to the Bachelor of Midwifery.

1. Bachelor of Midwifery – GU – Logan and Gold Coast
2. Bachelor of Nursing – GU – Gold Coast
3. Bachelor of Nursing – GU – Logan
4. Bachelor of Nursing – GU – Nathan
5. Bachelor of Public Health – GU – Gold Coast
6. Bachelor of Child and Family Studies – GU – Logan

Applicant C

Received OP 14

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their fourth preference. They could conditionally accept this offer and wait to be considered for a higher preference in the later offer rounds. If they don't receive an offer into a higher preference, they can accept their offer into the Bachelor of Health Science as a pathway to the Bachelor of Midwifery.

1. Bachelor of Midwifery – GU – Logan and Gold Coast
2. Bachelor of Nursing – GU – Logan
3. Bachelor of Nursing – GU – Gold Coast
4. Bachelor of Health Science – GU – Gold Coast
5. Bachelor of Social Work – GU – Logan
6. Bachelor of Child and Family Studies – GU – Logan
