Wealth Paifang Completes Chinatown Precinct!

The final step in delivering streetscape and cultural embellishments in the Gold Coast Chinatown Precinct Plan was officially dedicated on 2 March 2018 by Mayor Tom Tate and the Consul-General of the People's Republic of China in Brisbane, Dr Xu Jie. Tourism Confucius Directors Prof Leong Liew and Prof Chaojie Liu also attended the dedication.

The Wealth Paifang, or gateway, spans 14 metres across Davenport Street, near Davison Lane and stands about nine metres. It was designed in collaboration with our Friendship City Chengdu, the Chengdu Municipal People's Government, Chengdu Dov. Design Co. and Urban Art Projects.

Mayor Tate said this was a momentous occasion for the city, "Since 2013, streetscape improvements, cultural embellishments and the construction of three paifangs marking the entrances to Gold Coast Chinatown have provided the foundation for the precinct."
