## 1.0 NAME OF AWARD

## 3.0 NATURE OF AWARD

- 3.1 \$1000.00 made as a one-off payment, to be used to travel interstate to attend auditions within 12 months after the competition date.
- 3.2 The recipient will provide an update document, at six months and at the end of twelve months, outlining the use of monies and any outcomes directly attributed to the award's support and must include copies of receipts for flights and accommodation while attending auditions. This is to be emailed to the Griffith University Scholarships office.
- 3.3 If the progress reports are not received at six and twelve months, the recipient will need to repay the funds.
- 3.4 The recipient may be invited to attend an event to meet the donors.
- 3.5 The recipient's use of the award monies may be postponed due to extenuating circumstances substantiated by a medical certificate. Deferment must not exceed six months. Thereafter, any outstanding award monies will be forfeited and reinvested in the Award.
- 3.6 Should the recipient receive a job offer within the performing arts before the award monies have been fully expended, the award monies may be utilised for re-location expenses and/or further training opportunities such as workshops and classes.

## 4.0 DURATION OF AWARD

4.1 The Award is offered on an annual basis

## 5.0 ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARD

- 5.1 Applicants must be enrolled in the third year of the Musical Theatre program at the Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University
- 5.2 Applicants must be an Australian Citizen, Australian Permanent Resident or a person who holds an Australian Permanent Humanitarian Visa (or its equivalent)
- 5.3 Applicants must <u>not</u> have a family home (parent or guardian) in either Sydney or Melbourne.
- 5.4 Applicants should not hold any other Griffith University scholarship that serves the same core purpose.
- 5.5 Applicants should demonstrate reasonable financial need to be eligible for this award.

#### 6.0 SELECTION PROCESS

- 6.1 Applicants must complete in full the application form including:
  - Documentation of financial need (E.G. Centrelink, ATO Assessment Notices or any formal documentation you see fit); students may also provide a written statement regarding financial need to accompany documentation.

- A written statement of no more than 400 words outlining their ambition and anticipated use of, and benefit from, the Award monies
- Provide 2<sup>nd</sup> year GPA and marking sheets from the 'Musicale Performances' to demonstrate high level of skill in singing, dancing and acting,
- 6.2 Applications will be assessed by the Selection Panel and a shortlist will be drawn up.
- 6.3 Shortlisted applicants will be judged by the Selection Panel for their performance and professionalism in the annual mainstage performance and the annual end of year showcase.
- 6.4 The winner will be chosen based on their written application AND live performance.
- 6.5 Candidates who do not submit all the relevant documentation listed in 6.1 above with their entry form will not qualify to take part in the competition.
- The Adjudication panel will be made up of the Head of Performing Arts, or their selected representative; one outside professional involved in, or with extensive experience in, Musical Theatre; and one donor, or their selected representative.

## 7.0 ADMINISTRATION OF THE AWARD

7.1 The Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University will be responsible for the administration of the prize, including the publicising of the prize and managing funds associated with the prize.
