Griffith University was the leading university for athlete numbers at both the Paris 2024 Olympics and Paralympics (UniSport Australia). Griffith also led the way at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics and Paralympics, Rio 2016 Olympics, Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games and Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games, where Griffith had the most athletes from any Australian university competing.






The Gold Coast Aquatic Centre has a 50m heated pool, housing a Swimming Australia high-performance program, and a functional fitness studio and gym.

### **High-performance swimming program**

Swimming Australia and Griffith University have a four year high-performance partnership until 2028. Under this partnerships the Griffith Swimming Club, located on the Gold Coast campus, is proud to be a Swimming Australia's high-performance supported hub—the only such program on the Gold Coast.

Under the leadership of world-renowned coach Melanie Marshall OLY and supported by Janelle Pallister OLY, the club runs an elite training program that has produced multiple Olympians. In addition, a development pathway program is offered, coached by Thomas Fraser-Holmes OLY, providing opportunities for emerging






### **Griffith Sports College eligibility**

If you compete at a state, national or international level in your sport, you might be eligible to join the Griffith Sports College.

Elite athletes\* are identified as participating in an AIS and Griffith University recognised sport. We base eligibility on advice from state and national sporting organisations, professional sporting clubs and/or recognised player associations.

### **Sports scholarships**

Griffith sports scholarships are offered to elite athletes who have excelled in their chosen sport.

The following scholarships are available to commencing and/or current students:

- Griffith Sports Excellence Scholarships | \$28,000 over four years
- Griffith Sports Development Scholarships | \$5,000 for one year
- The Clem Jones Scholarship | \$9,000 for three years
- · Swimming Australia Scholarships | \$5,000 for one year
- · Adam Scott Foundation Sports Business Scholarships | HECS fees for up to three years
- Ron Clark Scholarship supported by Commonwealth Games Australia (First Nations athlete) | \$44,000 for up to four years
- Easts Rugby Union Scholarship | \$5,000 for one year


# Our leader knows what it's like to perform at the top of their sport.


Gold-medal winning Olympian Naomi McCarthy (water polo) combines her experience as an elite athlete with management expertise to assist our cohort of talented athletes.
