

Introduction

This guide will show you how to connect to Griffith University Wi-Fi network on an Android device.

Before you start - The onboarding process requires an active internet connection. If you are on campus and require temporary access, connect to the *Setup Griffith WiFi SSID.

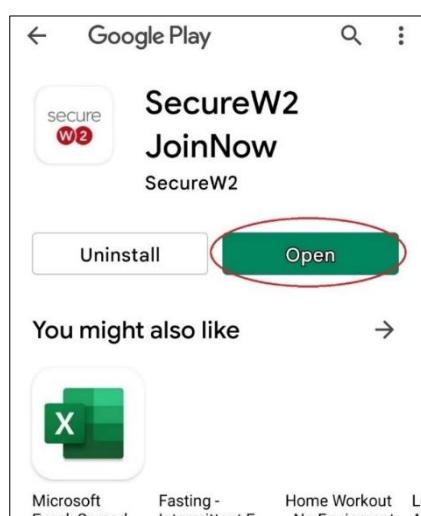
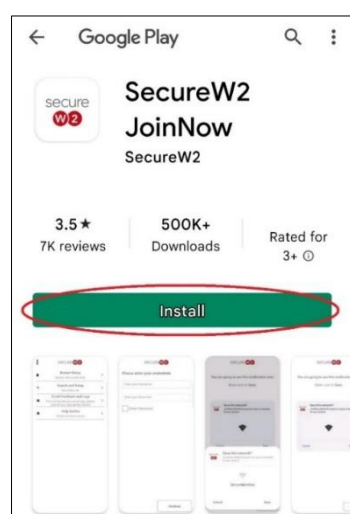

Part A: Download and set up SecureW2 JoinNow

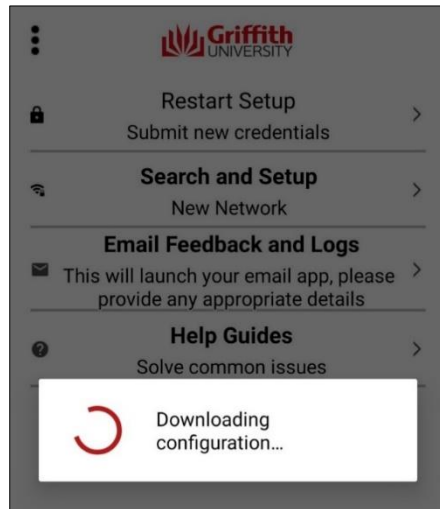
- 1 Open **Chrome** browser and go to **wifi.griffith.edu.au**.
- 2 Select **Download**. This will take you to the SecureW2 Google Play page.



- 3 Tap **Install**. Once the SecureW2 JoinNow app has installed tap **Open**.



- 4 The app will begin the setup process.



- 5 Sign in with your **Griffith sNumber** and **Griffith password** (e.g sXXXXXXX).

Part B: Test Wi-Fi connection

- 1 Once the setup process is complete, tap **Go to Wi-Fi Settings**.



- 2 Tap on **Griffith University** to connect to the Griffith University Wi-Fi network (it may take up to one minute for the network to appear). Once connected, try browsing the internet to check your connection to Griffith University Wi-Fi is working correctly.

- 3 If you are having trouble connecting, open the **Griffith University** network settings select **Use device MAC** or **Phone MAC**. This setting may be in the **Privacy** sub-menu.
