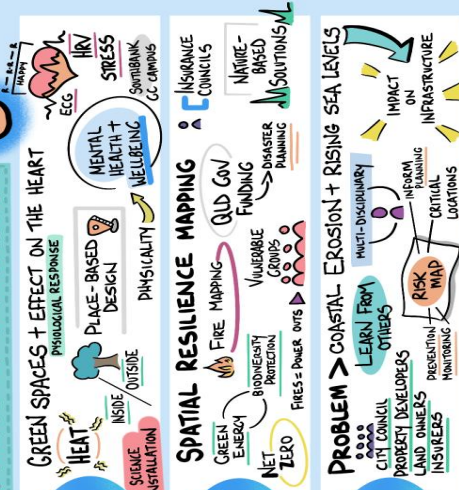

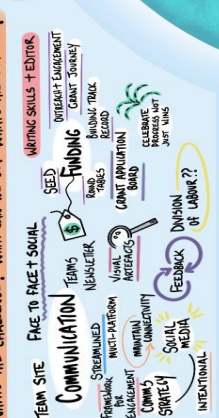

## Collaborative and Transdisciplinary Research Opportunities

- Australian Research Council collaborations (\$250k–\$10M)\*
- Cooperative Research Centres (CRC) Grants (\$30–70M, 7–10 years)\*
- CRC Projects (Industry-led, \$3M+ up to 3 years)\*
- National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC) Grants and Medical Research Future Funding (MRFF) Grants (\$250k–\$5M)\*
- Griffith Co-Sponsored PhD Program
- Co-design an industry-oriented research area
- Co-sponsor PhD student for \$30k/year, matched by Griffith University
- CSIRO Industry–Griffith PhD (Industry top-up \$13k/year for 4 years)
- National Industry PhD Program (Industry top-up \$10k/year for 4 years)
