Safety First: Every child has the right to feel safe, respected, and heard.

Cultural Safety: We recognise that cultural respect is an important part of child safety and are committed to fostering environments where all children feel safe and valued.

Inclusive Practices: We welcome and support all children, including those with disabilities and from culturally diverse backgrounds.

Clear Standards: All staff follow Griffith University's Code of Conduct, which sets expectations for safe and respectful behaviour.

Safe Reporting: Children, families, and staff can report concerns through accessible and child-friendly processes. All concerns are taken seriously and acted on promptly.

OUR ACTIONS

- Publicly display our commitment in physical and online spaces.
- Provide ongoing training for staff on child safety.
- Maintain robust recruitment and screening practices, including Blue Card compliance.
- Regularly review and improve our procedures and practices.
