



# Making the most of your preferences

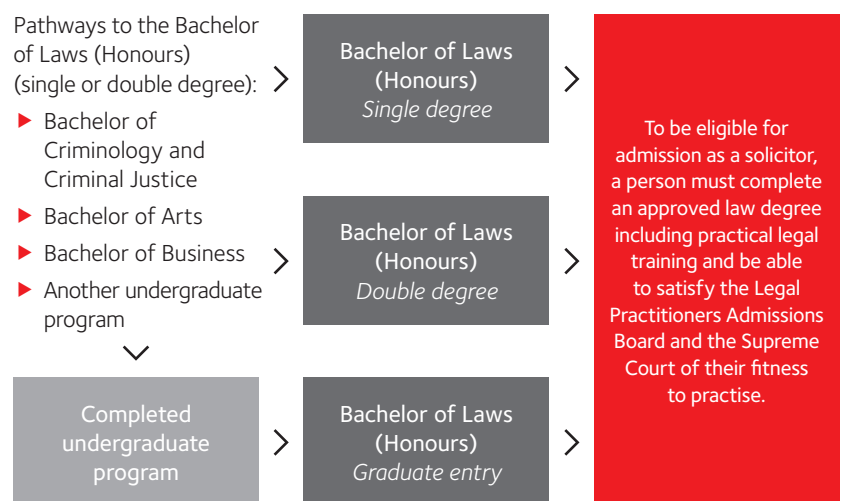
## Bachelor of Laws (Honours)

*To make the most of your preferences it is important to include pathways or related programs as options.*

If you are interested in a career in Law the most direct route is via the Bachelor of Laws (Honours), however competition for limited places means that talented applicants miss out every year.

By studying another program for one year and achieving a high GPA, you may increase your selection rank to be competitive for an offer into the Bachelor of Laws (Honours). This can be achieved through another program from any discipline, however recommended options include the Bachelor of Criminology and Criminal Justice, Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Business. There are also a wide range of double degrees featuring the Bachelor of Laws (Honours). If you are interested in studying a double degree with Laws (Honours), an option is to list the non-Laws single program as a pathway.

Once you have completed at least a year of study in the alternate program, if you still wish to study Laws you can apply for Internal Transfer into either the single or a double Laws degree. You could also complete the program and apply for the Bachelor of Laws (Honours) (Graduate entry).

# Preferencing examples

## Applicant A

### Received OP 15

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their third preference. They could conditionally accept this offer and wait to be considered for a higher preference in the later offer rounds. If they don't receive an offer into a higher preference, they can accept their offer into the Bachelor of Criminology and Criminal Justice as a pathway to the Bachelor of Laws (Honours), either transferring after completion of one year, or completing and applying for the Bachelor of Laws (Honours) (Graduate entry).

Note. 2019 minimum OP used as an example only.

## Applicant B

### Received OP 15

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their fifth preference. They can accept their offer into the Bachelor of Business as a pathway into the Bachelor of Laws (Honours)/Bachelor of Commerce or the Bachelor of Laws (Honours)/Bachelor of Business.
