

Introduction

This guide will show you how to connect to Griffith University Wi-Fi on a Chromebook device.

Before you start - You must be on campus to complete the steps in this guide. You also need to close all applications using Wi-Fi/Internet before attempting the steps in this guide (including Outlook and Microsoft 365).

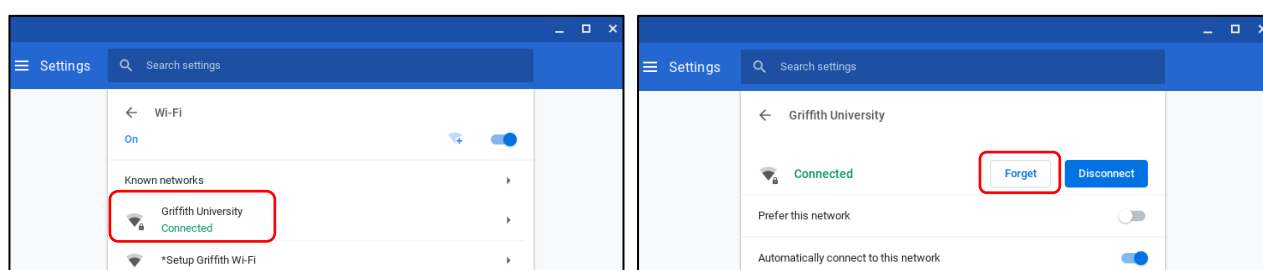
Screenshots in this guide may differ depending on device and software versions.

Have you connected to Griffith Wi-Fi or Eduroam from your device before?

No – Continue to **Part A: Connect to *Setup Griffith Wi-Fi**.

Yes – You will need to forget the **Griffith University** and **Eduroam** Wi-Fi networks on your device.

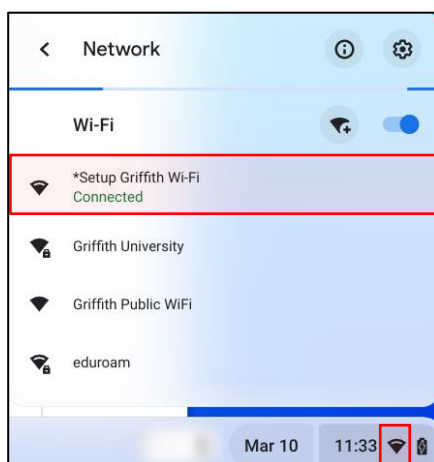
- 1 Open the **Wi-Fi Settings** on your device. Click on **Griffith University** and select **Forget**.



- 2 Repeat the same as above for the **Eduroam** Wi-Fi network, then continue to **Part A: Connect to *Setup Griffith Wi-Fi**.

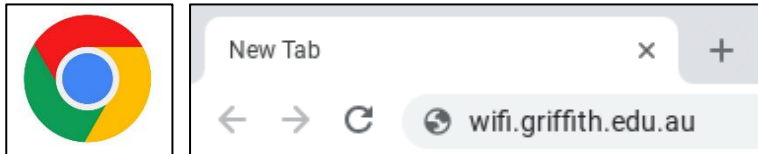
Part A: Connect to *Setup Griffith Wi-Fi

- 1 From the **Wi-Fi Network** menu on your device, select ***Setup Griffith Wi-Fi** and wait for your device to connect.



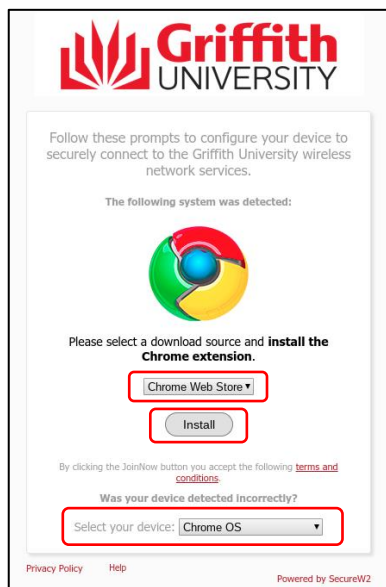
Part B: Download and set up SecureW2 JoinNow

- 1 Open **Google Chrome** browser and go to **wifi.griffith.edu.au**

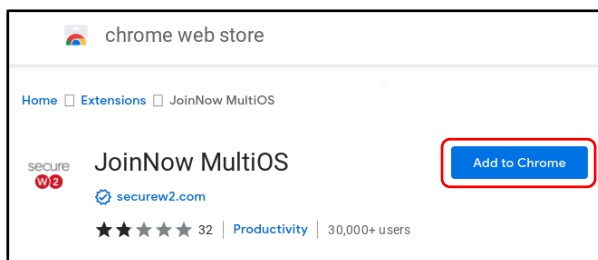


- 2 On the next screen:

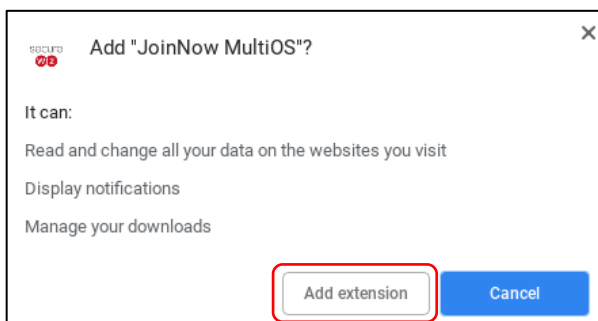
- Select **Chrome Web Store**
- Set **Select your device to Chrome OS**
- Click **Install**.



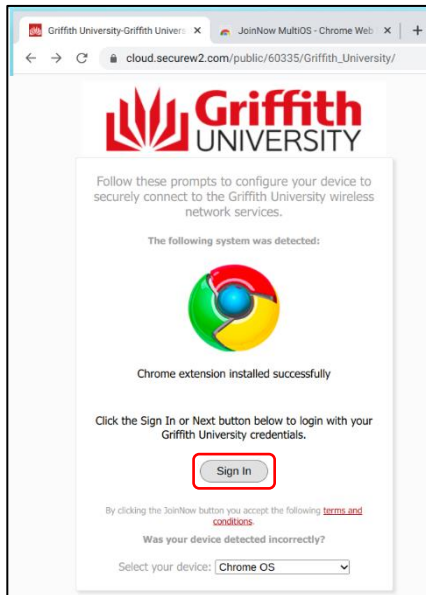
- 3 Click **Add to Chrome**.



- 4 Select **Add Extension**.



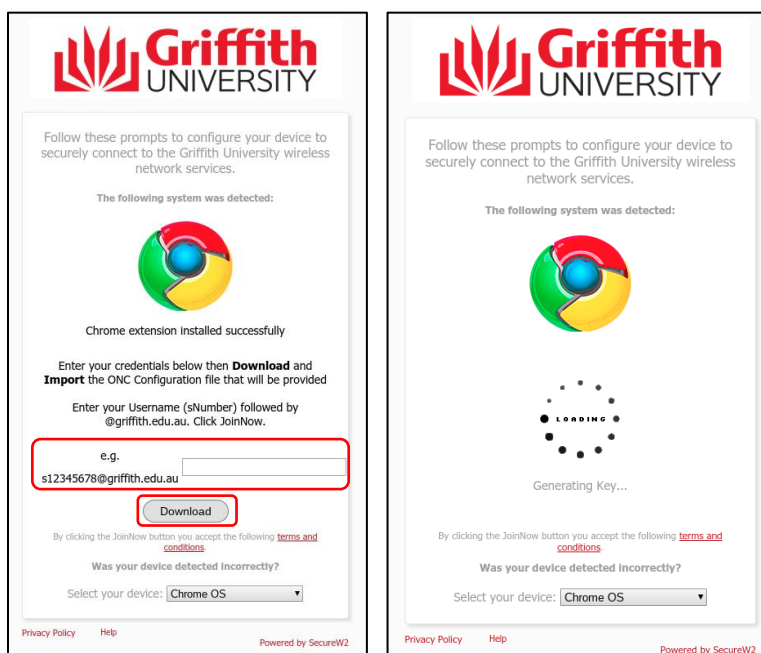
- 5 Once the extension has installed, return to the **Griffith University wireless network** tab and click **Sign In**.



- 6 Sign in using your **Griffith sNumber** and **Griffith password** (e.g. s12345678).

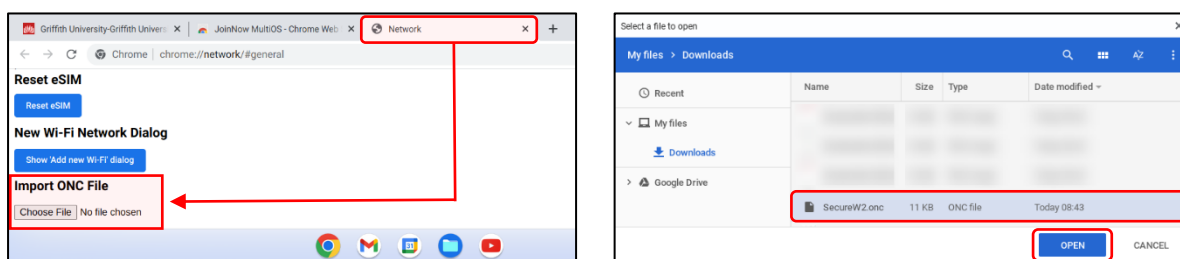
- 7 Enter your **sNumber** followed by **@griffith.edu.au** (e.g. s12345678@griffith.edu.au) and click **Download**.

The **SecureW2.onc** file will download to your device.

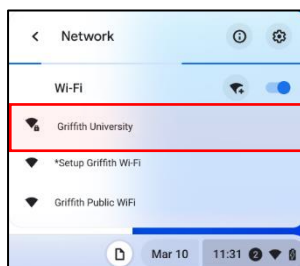


8 Click on the newly opened **Network** tab in your browser.

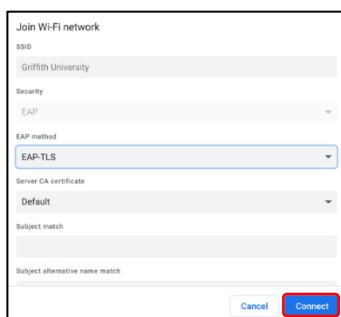
- Scroll down and under **Import ONC file** select **Choose File**.
- Locate the **SecureW2.onc** file from your downloads folder and select **Open**.



9 Return to your **Wi-Fi Settings** and click on **Griffith University** from the list of Wi-Fi networks.

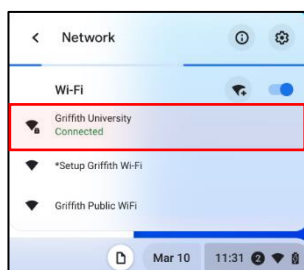


10 On the **Join Wi-Fi network** screen, click **Connect**.



Part C: Test Wi-Fi connection

1 In **Wi-Fi Settings** check your device is now connected to the **Griffith University** Wi-Fi network (it may take up to one minute for the network to appear).



2 Once connected, try browsing the internet to check your connection to Griffith University Wi-Fi is working correctly.
