

All students must complete orientation before commencing a placement within a Queensland Health facility. **You will not be able to commence your placement until your orientation is completed.**

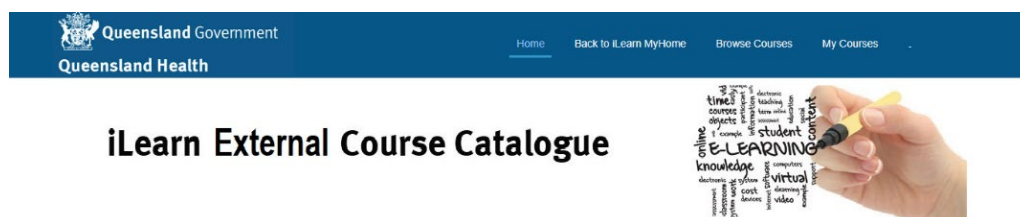
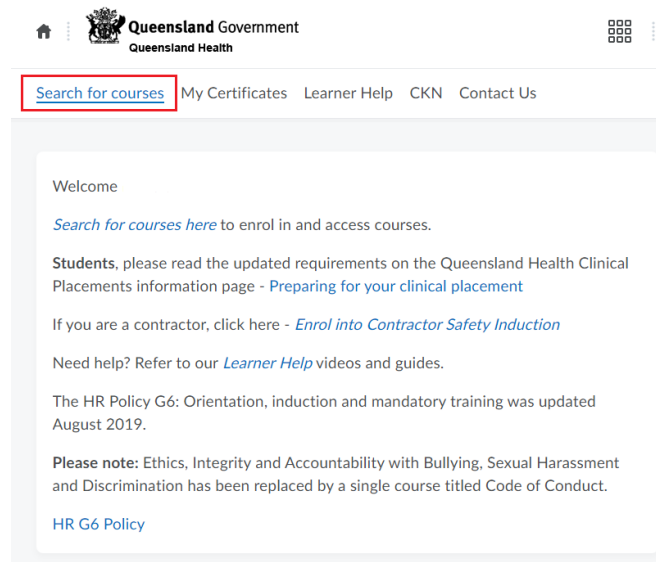
How do I complete the Queensland Health Orientation Online Training?
