## 4. Exemption from the English Language Enhancement Course (ELEC)

International students admitted via one of the following English admission pathways are NOT REQUIRED to complete the English Language Enhancement Course;

- i. At least IELTS (Academic) of 7.0 with no subscore below 6.5 within the last two years;
- ii. At least TOEFL (paper based) 580 within the last two years;
- iii. At least TOEFL (internet based) 92 with no score less than 22 within the last two years;
- iv. At least ISLPR 4 in each skill within the last two years;
- v. a minimum overall score of 185 (no score less than 176) on C2 Proficiency (formerly Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English)
- vi. At least a score of 65 in each band of the Pearson Test of English (Academic) \* Refer to <u>Undergraduate programs Admissions</u> policy. Schedule B for specified programs for which the Pearson Test of English (Academic) does not satisfy English language entry requirements
- vii. Satisfactory completion of one of the qualifications specified in Schedule A to the Admission Policy for Undergraduate Programs;
- viii. Satisfactory completion within the past five years from Canada (excluding Quebec), New Zealand, Australia, Republic of Ireland, United States or United Kingdom of senior secondary, post-secondary, Higher Education Sector accredited associate degree- or degree-level study, or equivalent for at least two years fulltime equivalent. Note these students will not be required to complete the ELE course. This includes:
  - a. senior secondary study (excluding Foundation program studies) or equivalent where the duration of study was at least two years;
  - b. post-secondary study where the study duration was at least two years;
  - VET-Sector accredited certificate, diploma, advanced diploma (e.g. TAFE) where the combined program duration
    was at least two years;
  - d. A Higher Education Sector accredited associate degree or degree, or equivalent where the study duration was at least two years;

ix. Satisfactory completion within the past five years of at least two years full-time equivalent post-secondary, Higher Education Sector accredited associate degree- or degree-level study, or equivalent in a country as specified in Schedule A to the Admission Policy for Undergraduate Programs in which the language of instruction and assessment/examination for the entire two years was in English.
