- The audition panel for each instrument will consist of Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University Specialist
- Students unsuccessful for a place in AHEP will have their nomination transferred to be considered for a place in SHEP Queensland which is held from Thursday 1 Sunday 4 October.
- Students and nominating teachers will be notified of the outcome of the audition once all auditions have been Assessed which is usually mid end of May.

AHEP AUDITION INFORMATION 2026

- We encourage students wishing to audition for AHEP to start preparing for their audition submission as soon as possible.
- Students will still need to be nominated by their teacher for AHEP, nominations are due by February 14
- Nominated students will receive an email from us late February which will confirm their nomination details and instructions and upload link for the audition

Audition Requirements

WIND/STRING (brass, percussion, and string)

Students need to complete both A and B

- a. All excerpts for your nominated instrument, and
- b. two contrasting unaccompanied sections of a piece of your choice not exceeding 3 mins per piece.

Notes

- You are welcome to select pieces you have used recently for recitals or examinations
- Students wishing to audition for Wind orchestra and Big Band must provide the required auditions for Wind
 Orchestra and Big Band
- Percussion Need to complete all required excerpts on respective instruments to be considered. Own choice
 is only 2 pieces and recommend that one is on tuned and other is untuned.
- Flutes: If you also play piccolo, please submit an unaccompanied piece on this instrument
- Clarinets: If you also play Alto, Soprano clarinet you are welcome to submit audition for each
- Saxophones: If you play all 4 Sax (alto, Tenor, Soprano, Baritone) you are welcome to submit audition for each

BIG BAND

Students need to complete both A and B

- a. All excerpts for your nominated instrument, and
- b. two contrasting unaccompanied sections of a piece of your choice not exceeding 3 mins per piece.

Notes

- When selecting pieces for your own choice they need to by style appropriate for Big Band (Jazz/swing)
- You are welcome to select pieces you have used recently for recitals or examinations
- Students may elect to only audition for Big Band if they choose

VOCAL

Students need to complete:

2 solo unaccompanied (Acapella) sections of your choice not exceeding 3 minutes

- Choose contrasting pieces that you feel best represent your vocal ability
- Auditions should show good clear line and capacity of vocal production, freedom of tone production and evidence of good breath support
- You are welcome to select pieces you have used recently for recitals or examinations
- Students may elect to submit an audition to more than one Vocal type: eg audition for soprano and alto, if so you will need to submit 2 pieces as above for each voice type
- Ensure you name each file correctly with your name-vocal type-how many files
