



Adjustment Factor Pathways

We offer a range of adjustment factor pathways that recognise your academic achievements or personal circumstances and improve your chances of getting into Griffith.

Gold Coast and Logan Priority Access Pathway

If you're a local and new to tertiary study, you may be eligible for Priority Access. Eligible applicants are awarded two (2) location adjustments when applying for degrees at our Gold Coast and Logan campuses. The adjustment is automatically applied by QTAC or UAC.

Year 12 Subject Adjustment Pathway

We award subject adjustments for Senior subjects that require a high level of skill and knowledge and for university courses successfully completed in high school. As a current Year 12 student, you can be awarded two (2) adjustments per subject, including GUESTS courses, up to a maximum adjustment of six (6). This includes applicants currently undertaking their External Senior studies. You do not need to apply separately for the adjustment as this is automatically applied to eligible QTAC or UAC preferences. Details of eligible subjects is printed overleaf.

The maximum adjustments an applicant can receive is capped at eight (8). Subject prerequisites and additional entry requirements still apply, and some degrees are not eligible for adjustments.

Educational Access Scheme (EAS)

You can apply for EAS when you apply for an undergraduate degree through QTAC or UAC. EAS can help if you have experienced circumstances that negatively affected your studies. If eligible for EAS, you may receive an equity adjustment of up to eight (8) ranks which may improve your chance of receiving an offer.

OP 1-6 Guarantee

We award all applicants with an OP 1-6, or equivalent ATAR/Selection Rank, a guaranteed place in the next available intake of most Griffith degrees. You do not need to apply separately for the guarantee as this is automatically applied to eligible QTAC or UAC preferences. This pathway is also known as the 'Griffith High-Achiever Guarantee' in UAC. Non-School Leavers are also eligible for this pathway.

[^] GUESTS courses include those studied in the On-Campus and Online program or the At-School program eg Griffith Eng, Griffith Exercise and Sports Science, Griffith Health and Griffith Phys). Adjustment factors are also awarded for recognised GUESTS equivalents completed at other Tertiary institutions (e.g. QUT-START, UQ – Enhanced Studies Program).
