



GRIFFITH ASIA INSTITUTE VISITING FELLOWSHIPS 2019

Overview

These awards aim to attract recognised researchers and policy makers in the field of Asia-Pacific security, politics, economies and development, to visit the Griffith Asia Institute and work with members, present lectures and seminars, contribute to publications, commentary and other relevant activities.

The number of awards given will depend on the quality of the applicants. The Fellowship program is for up to four weeks with Fellows hosted at the Griffith Asia Institute.

Value

The fellowship will provide support for reasonable travel, accommodation and living expenses including:

- A return economy-class airfare and transfers.
- Stipend for living allowance of \$AUD 500 per week paid to the Fellow during the period of residence up to a maximum total of \$AUD 2,000.
- Remaining costs associated with reasonable accommodation for the term of the fellowship.

All expenses must be receipted or booked directly by the Griffith Asia Institute. The Griffith Asia Institute reserves the right to determine the total award amount. Visa costs, fares for dependants, medical insurance and removal expenses will not be provided.

Eligibility

- Proposed Fellows must be of international standing and be researching in an area that aligns with GAI's strategic priority research areas and work closely with a member of the Institute.
- Applicants must have a current institutional affiliation with a University or with an equivalent research organisation, and generally have at least a doctorate or equivalent professional experience, research, and publications
- Fellows are responsible for securing the approval of their institutions/organisations to undertake the fellowship, where required. This includes securing travel approval and authorisation, where required.
- Previous Fellows are ineligible to apply within two (2) years after completion of their fellowship.

Selection

- Applicants will be assessed by the Institute's executive on the basis of their research track record and/or work and its relevance to GAI as well as the potential researcher or institutional links.

Conditions

The Fellowship is awarded under the following conditions:

- The duration of the Fellowship shall be for a period of up to four weeks. Fellows are expected to be based at Griffith University (Nathan Campus) full time for the duration of the Fellowship.
- The value of the Fellowship is comprised of the following up to the maximum amounts specified in the guidelines:
 - A stipend (paid fortnightly on commencement of the fellowship)
 - Return economy class airfare to Brisbane from home airport, and airport transfers. Fares for dependants, medical insurance, visas and removal expenses will not be provided. Claims for travel expenses will be paid on production of an invoice or receipt.
 - Reasonable accommodation costs.
 - Access to the University library and other relevant infrastructure.
- Appointments must be commenced within six months of a formal letter of offer unless otherwise approved.
- Visiting Fellows are encouraged to engage and participate in workshops and seminars of Griffith Asia Institute.
- Successful candidates who undertake a Fellowship are required to publish an online article for the Institute and provide a detailed report on key research outcomes resulting from the Fellowship, with a particular emphasis on how it will contribute to publication outputs and/or grant application in collaboration with a GAI member at the conclusion of their Fellowship.
- Any Visiting Fellow considered not to be making satisfactory progress will have the fellowship reviewed by the Director of the Griffith Asia Institute who may terminate the fellowship.
- The Fellows agree to comply with all lawful directions and professional standards of the host University.
- The University presently asserts and will continue to assert intellectual property rights as defined in and in accordance with the *Griffith University Intellectual Property Policy* <http://www62.gu.edu.au/policylibrary.nsf/xmainsearch/Oa1e4df4c2be64584a256bc100631d7d?opendocument> as amended or replaced.

Preparing an Application

Applicants must:

- Complete the relevant application form
- Provide a summary of research/work and proposed researcher/institutional links
- Provide an abridged Curriculum Vitae up to 4 pages in length
