Bachelor of Communication and Journalism/Bachelor of Government and International Relations

Amid the 24-hour news cycle, become competitive in a range of sectors—either as a journalist, political strategist, or media advisor. Acquire specialist training in essential aspects of contemporary media management—including social media communication, public policy making, political campaigning and international advocacy.

Bachelor of Communication and Journalism/Bachelor of Science

Graduates of this double degree will better navigate the contemporary context for science, where global communication and media are prevalent. Alongside scientific expertise, students will develop a suite of communication, writing and media production skills that will add a critical dimension to their employability.

You can choose to combine two degrees from related fields to become a specialist, or degrees from different areas of interest to broaden your choices. With our extensive range of study areas, you're bound to find a combination that's right for you.

How does it work?

When you study a double degree, you'll complete the two degrees at the same time, usually over four or five years. As a double degree graduate, you'll receive two degree certificates—one for each qualification.

Final year capstone course

In your final year of study, you'll complete a capstone course that will bring together the knowledge and skills you've gained in each component of your double degree.

Hands-on industry experience

Our double degrees include opportunities for industry internships and work placements, so you'll make practical connections within and between each of your areas of study.

Finish faster

With our trimester calendar, you may have the option to complete a double degree in the same length of time as a single degree by taking courses (subject to availability) in every trimester each year.

How to apply for a double degree

You can apply through the Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC) or the University Admissions Centre (UAC: New South Wales-based admissions system, available for degrees at our Gold Coast campus only).

Early-bird applications close in late September 2019. Applications will be accepted after this date but you may need to pay a late fee. Apply online at:

Application tip

You can list up to six preferences on your QTAC or five preferences on your UAC application. You'll receive an offer for the highest preference you're eligible for.

If you're applying for a double degree, it's a good idea to list the two component single degrees as preferences as well—these may be easier to gain entry to. You may have the chance to upgrade to a double degree from a single degree after a year of study.
