Accessing your Records and Vaccination Schedules

Australian Immunisation Handbook

Griffith Health recommends students are vaccinated in accordance with the recommendations of the current edition of the <u>Australian Immunisation Handbook</u>. Various placements may have different immunisation requirements. Ensure that you are aware of what is required for your specific placement and refer to the handbook for more information about what each immunisation is for.

How to Demonstrate Compliance

You are responsible for all costs associated with meeting the immunisation and health requirements. The <u>Griffith University Health Service</u> medical centre provides vaccine and serology at a discounted cost.

You will need to provide the vaccine batch numbers. However if you have been vaccinated in the past and batch numbers were not recorded, a copy of a baby/immunisation booklet or letter from the GP outlining the dates of vaccination may be sufficient. The exception is:

 dTpa (adult diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis), for which serology result is not accepted (i.e. only evidence of dTpa vaccination is accepted).
