



Making the most of your preferences

Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production

To make the most of your preferences it is important to include pathways or related programs as options.

If you are interested in a career in Film the most direct route is via the Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production, however competition for limited places means that talented applicants miss out every year.

By studying another program for one year and achieving a high GPA, you may increase your selection rank to be competitive for an offer into the Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production. This can be achieved through another program from any discipline, however recommended options include the Bachelor of Games Design, and Bachelor of Arts.

Once you have completed a year of study in the alternate program, if you still wish to study the Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production, you can apply for an internal transfer.

Pathways to the Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production:

- ▶ Bachelor of Games Design
- ▶ Bachelor of Arts
- ▶ Another undergraduate program.

Admission via these programs is subject to meeting eligibility criteria.

Preferencing examples

Applicant A

Received OP 12

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their third preference. If they do not receive an offer for their higher preferences, they may use the Bachelor of Games Design as a pathway into the Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production.

Note. 2018 minimum OP used as an example only.

1. Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production – GU – South Bank
2. Bachelor of Animation – GU – South Bank
3. Bachelor of Games Design – GU – South Bank
4. Bachelor of Design – GU – South Bank
5. Bachelor of Fine Art – GU – South Bank
6. Bachelor of Arts – GU – Nathan

Applicant B

Received OP 15

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their fifth preference. They can accept their offer into the Bachelor of Arts as a pathway to the Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production.

1. Bachelor of Film and Screen Media Production – GU – South Bank
2. Bachelor of Games Design – GU – South Bank
3. Bachelor of Creative and Interactive Media – GU – Gold Coast
4. Bachelor of Design – GU – Gold Coast
5. Bachelor of Arts – GU – Gold Coast
6. Bachelor of Business – GU – Gold Coast
