5.1 Awarded to two full-time Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University classical voice and classical piano students for the best partnership between vocalist and accompanist

**6.0 SELECTION PROCESS**

- 6.1 Competitors are required to perform:
- a song by Handel or Purcell
  - a French Melodie sung in the original language, and
  - a German lied sung in the original language
- 6.2 Judges are to be appointed by the Director or his nominee. No judge may be the teacher of a student who is competing.

- 6.3 A preliminary round may be held if required.
