# **WOMENS PARTICIPATION RATES**

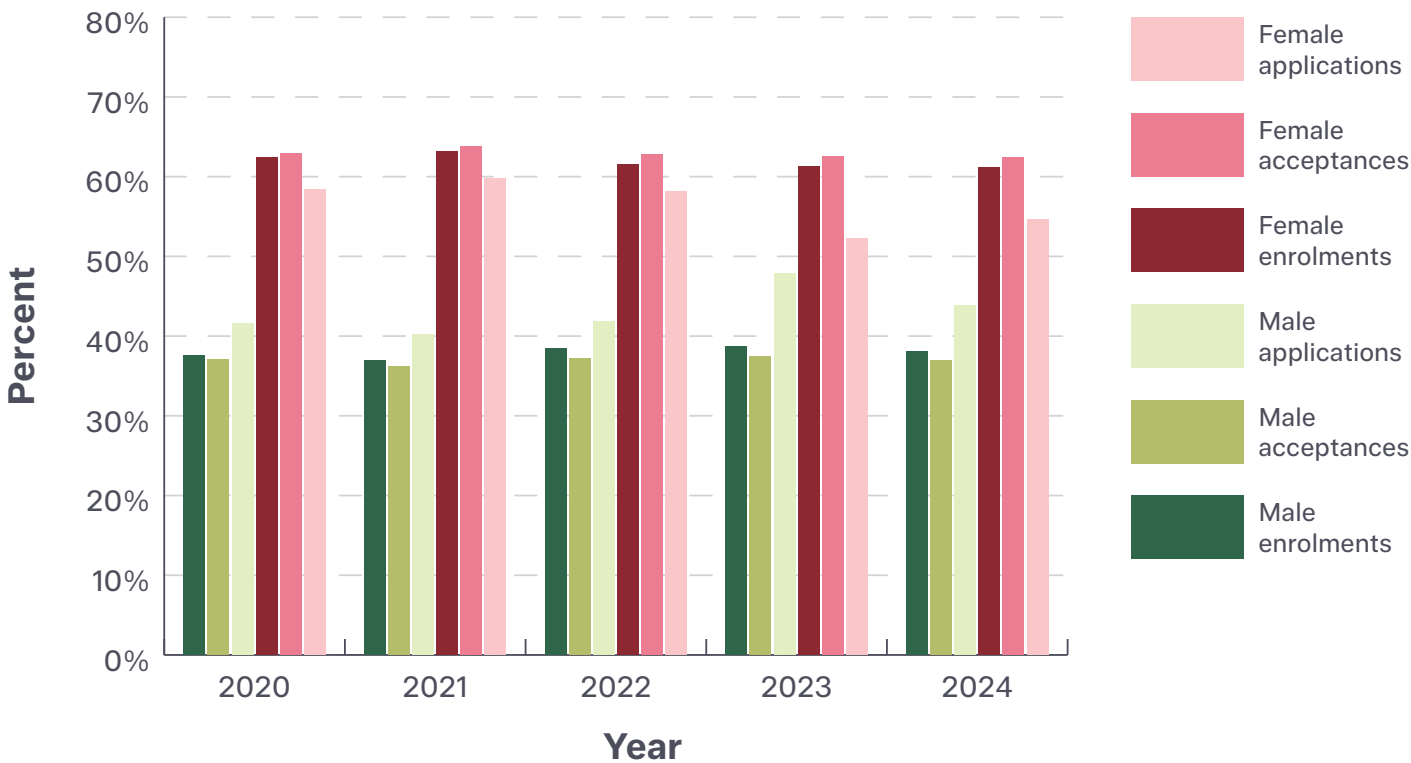


At Griffith, we systematically measure and track women’s application rate, acceptance and entry rate, and their graduation rate as reflected in the data below.



## Applications, acceptances and enrolments by gender

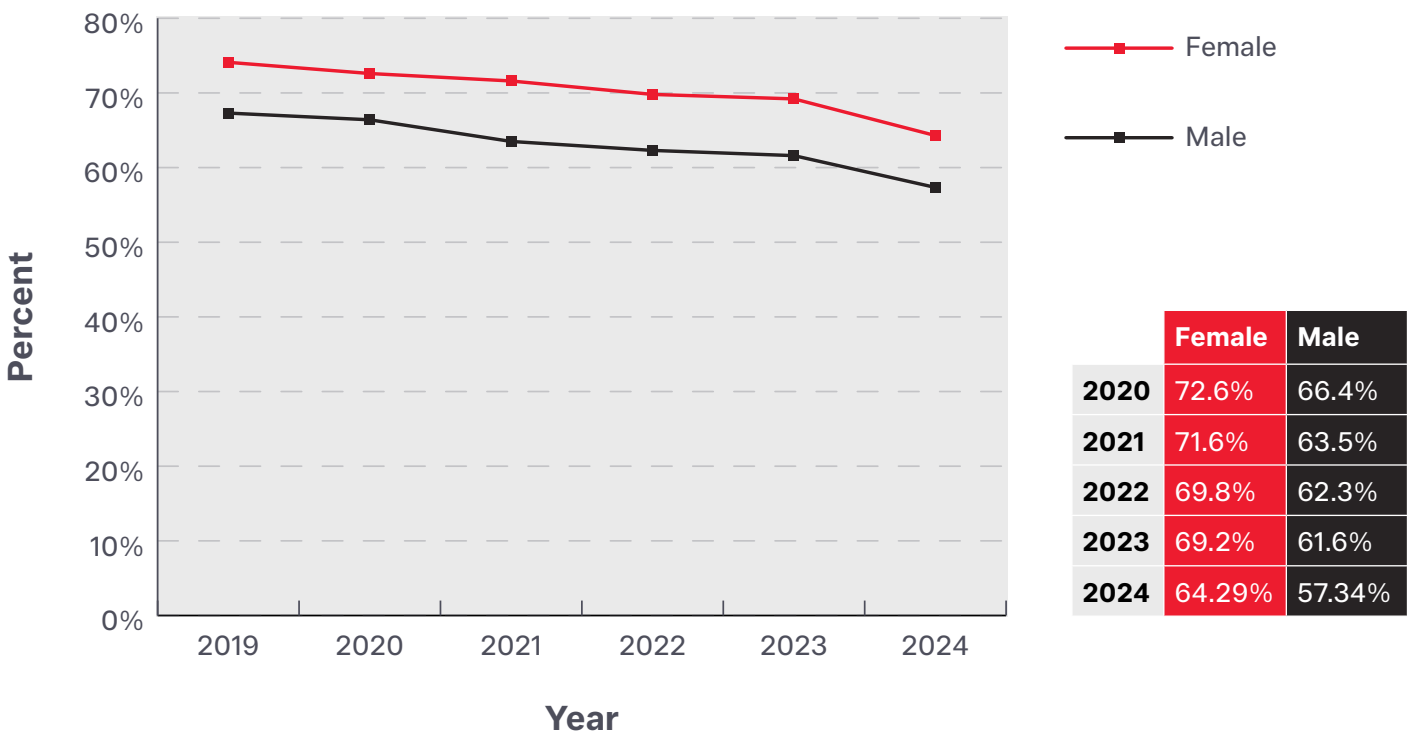
Women have been the majority of applications, acceptance and enrolments since 2020.
