



# Upgrading pathways

*Bridging and enabling programs and admission pathways are available to satisfy subject prerequisite requirements or to upgrade to your preferred Griffith degree.*

## **Selection Ranks and Meeting subject prerequisites**

Selection Ranks can be awarded for your senior secondary study, tertiary or other qualifications. You can have more than one Selection Rank, which are assessed in order from highest to lowest.

If you have not met your prerequisite requirements via your senior secondary studies, Griffith accepts a range of ways to meet subject prerequisite or assumed knowledge requirements. These approved equivalent studies can be found on the Assumed prior knowledge website.

## **What is the difference between a bridging course and an enabling program?**

Enabling programs can provide pathways to university study if you lack formal qualifications required for admission into an undergraduate degree. If you have not studied prerequisite subjects such as English, Maths B or Science, bridging courses can provide you with an opportunity to bridge the gap between your level of knowledge whilst meeting the subject prerequisite requirements.

We offer a number of bridging courses to prospective and commencing students. These courses can provide you with the necessary study to:

- meet prerequisite requirements
- brush up on your knowledge or skills in a particular subject area

### **Certificate IV in Adult Tertiary Preparation (CATP)**

Successful completion of the Certificate IV in Adult Tertiary Preparation from TAFE Queensland is an excellent admission pathway to a range of Griffith degrees. You can also undertake specific modules to meet subject prerequisite requirements.

### **Griffith University Preparation Program (GUPP)**

We deliver a tertiary enabling program at Logan campus for mature age applicants. This program provides a pathway for those who wish to undertake study at Griffith University but lack the formal qualifications required for admission into an undergraduate degree. Successful completion of this program meets the Griffith English subject prerequisite, and you will be eligible for admission into a range of Griffith undergraduate degrees.

### Single Course of Study at Griffith

Successfully completing a minimum of two single courses (subjects) of study can provide you with a Selection Rank for admission into an undergraduate degree as well as meeting the Griffith English subject prerequisite.


### Special Tertiary Admissions Test (STAT)

The STAT is a two-hour multiple choice exam. If you are a non-current school-leaver who is 18 years of age or over, you can sit this exam and gain a Selection Rank for admission into most Griffith degrees. A high score in STAT may also meet the Griffith English subject prerequisite for some degrees.
