

### Quick Guide to Griffith Credentials for worker learners

#### What are they?

Griffith Credentials are verified digital badges and micro-credentials that allow you to easily communicate your skills and accomplishments online. All credentials are certified by Griffith University and contain verified metadata describing your achievement and the process required to earn it. They can be used in email signatures, digital resumes, personal websites, and social media platforms, and are a great way to increase opportunities in the workforce and beyond.

#### What is their value?

Griffith Credentials are designed to upskill you for the workplace of tomorrow and to develop the most in-demand workplace skills and address emerging trends facing your industry. 








# 4 Simple Steps to Claim your Griffith Credentials





## How do you claim and share them?

Once you have earned a badge, you will receive a confirmation email from Griffith and a notification from Credly (the digital badge platform) on how to set up your account, claim and share your badge. Please create your Credly account and claim your badge as soon as possible, so that you can start to gain the benefits!

You can let potential employers know about your new credential by showcasing it and sharing your digital badge on LinkedIn, Facebook, Twitter, via email and embedded in your resume, personal website and email signature. On LinkedIn, digital badges appear under the licenses and certifications heading. This is where you will be able to show off your Griffith Credentials badges. People checking out your profile can click 'see credential', which links to a page on Credly with information such as the description of the award, the relevant skills and the earning criteria.
