PURPOSE

The Bachelor Honours Degree qualifies individuals who apply a body of knowledge in a specific context to undertake professional work and as a pathway for research and further learning

KNOWLEDGE

Graduates of a Bachelor Honours Degree will have coherent and advanced knowledge of the underlying principles and concepts in one or more disciplines and knowledge of research principles and methods.

Graduates of the Bachelor of Visual Arts (Honours) will have:

- Advanced knowledge of the underlying principles and concepts of visual arts discipline and their chosen area of focus,
- Demonstrated knowledge of research principles and methods appropriate to the visual arts.

SKILLS

Graduates of a Bachelor Honours Degree will have:

- cognitive skills to review, analyse, consolidate and synthesise knowledge to identify and provide solutions to complex problems with intellectual independence
- cognitive and technical skills to demonstrate a broad understanding of a body of knowledge and theoretical concepts with advanced understanding in some areas
- cognitive skills to exercise critical thinking and judgement in developing new understanding
- technical skills to design and use research in a project
- communication skills to present a clear and coherent exposition of knowledge and ideas to a variety of audiences

Graduates of the Bachelor of Visual Arts (Honours) will be able to:

- Identify and synthesise relevant and appropriate sources of information and research methods, critically evaluating their own work and the work of others,
- Recognise and reflect on diverse social, cultural, and ethical issues particularly in relation to Indigenous protocols,
- Work independently when conceiving, researching, and developing visual arts projects that embrace diverse forms of artmaking,
- Develop and communicate visual arts outcomes in collaborative and diverse contexts informed by international and national theoretical, technical, and historical discourse in contemporary visual art.
