

Introduction

This guide will show you how to connect to the Griffith University Wi-Fi network on a MacOS device running Ventura.

Before you start - The onboarding process requires an active internet connection. If you are on campus and require temporary access, connect to the **Setup Griffith WiFi* SSID.

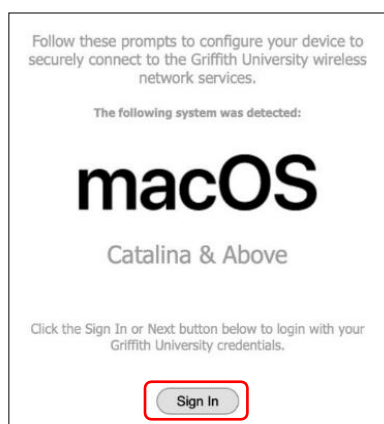

Part A: Download and set up SecureW2 JoinNow

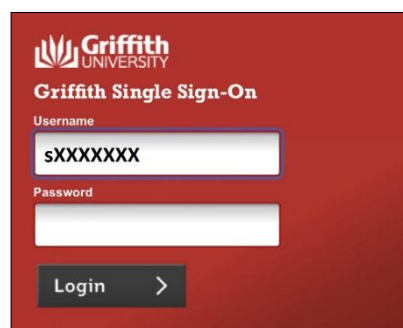
- 1 Open **Safari** and go to **wifi.griffith.edu.au**



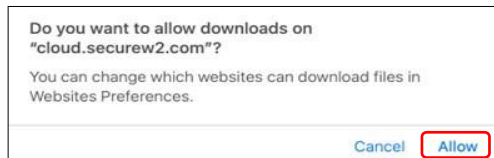
- 2 Click **Sign In**.



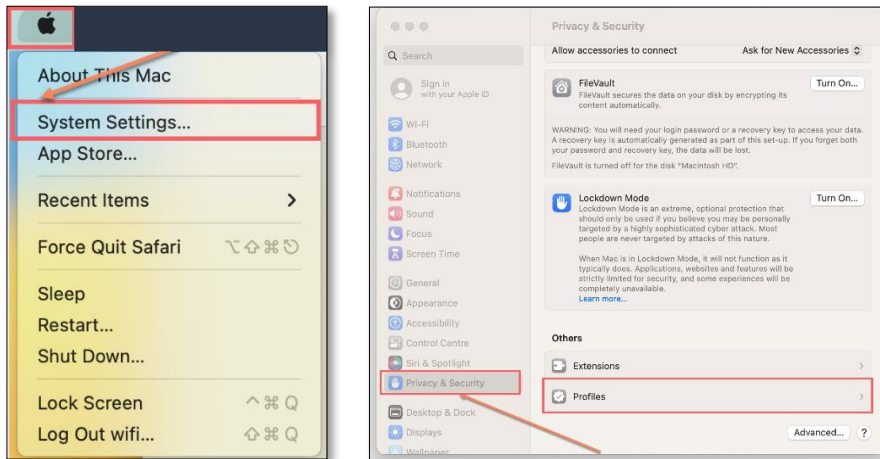
- 3 Sign in with your **Griffith sNumber** and **Griffith password** (e.g. sXXXXXXXX).



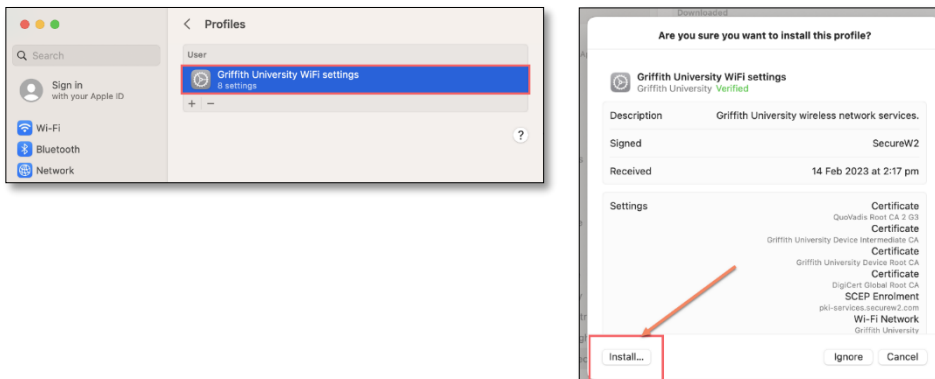
- 4 If prompted with the below, select **Allow**.



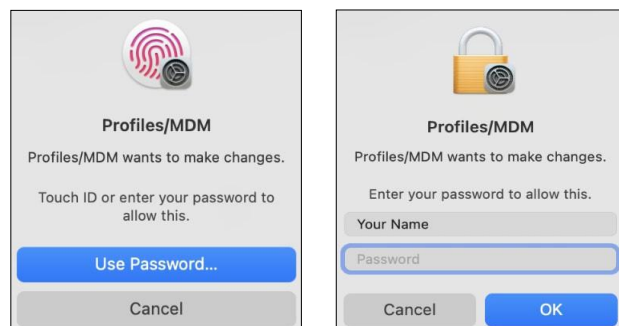
- 5 Open **System Settings**. Go to **Privacy and Security** and select **Profiles**.



- 6 Click on **Griffith University WiFi settings** and select **Install**. At the prompt click **Continue**.



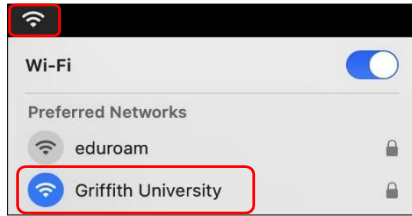
- 7 Authenticate using Touch ID or your computer password when prompted.



- 8 Once finished the certificate will show as **Installed**. If you receive an authentication error, the password entered may be incorrect and you will need to try installing the certificate again.

Part B: Test Wi-Fi connection

- 1 To complete the setup, open the **Wi-Fi** menu on your device and select **Griffith University** to connect. (It may take up to one minute for the network to appear)



- 2 If you are having trouble connecting, open the **Griffith University** wireless network settings and ensure **Private Wi-Fi address** is set to **Fixed**.
