1.0 NAME OF BURSARY

1.1 The Queensland Conservatorium International Travel Bursary – Orchestral Strings

2.0 DONOR OF BURSARY

3.0 NATURE OF BURSARY

3.1 For the 2023 academic year, the Bursary is a one-off payment of \$2,500 to support the recipient to travel overseas to further their study of orchestral stringed instruments.

4.0 DURATION OF BURSARY

4.1 The bursary will be awarded on an annual basis at the discretion of the Director.

5.0 ELIGIBILITY

5.1 The bursary is open to students wishing to travel overseas to further their study at postgraduate level at an approved school of music, university or institution; for tuition with an approved specific teacher or workshop; or to assist in attending an audition to secure such a place;

5.2 Applicants must be a current QCGU postgraduate student or a recent QCGU graduate (ie: an alum who graduated no more than three years ago);

5.3 Have received a letter of offer from the overseas organization confirming that a place has been offered to the applicant or that an audition has been arranged;

5.4 Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 5.0

6.0 SELECTION PROCESS

6.1 Applicants must submit a written application completed not later than **Friday 22 September 2023 4pm**

6.2 The application will include information about

- Which orchestral stringed instrument is played
- The tuition being offered overseas and why it offers more than can be provided in Australia
- Their GPA score – a minimum GPA of 5 is required
- Their career aspirations
- Other sources of income
- Are you a recent alumnus of QCGU having graduated no more than 3 years ago? Yes / No – indicate instrument
- Have you been a previous recipient of this bursary? Yes / No
- Have you ever won another prize, award, scholarship or bursary? Yes / No – please provide details
- Do you have an offer from an overseas organisation to study? Yes / No - If yes, please provide a copy of the Letter of Offer and provide information about the tuition eg name of organisation and coach, dates, location, cost, structure of course etc.
- What is the deadline for responding to the overseas offer?
- How will this course help you in advancing your skills / career?
- What difference will this bursary make to you being able to accept this offer?
- Is there a similar course being offered in Australia? Yes / No
- If yes, please explain why this is different
- Do you have any other form of income? Yes / No
- If yes, please estimate annual income

One QCGU lecturer or industry representative (with a knowledge of all stringed instruments but with no conflict of interest), the Conservatorium Manager and an alumnus will constitute the selection panel.

References will be sought from QCGU lecturers for the shortlist if one is required.
